Beautiful smile and was always fun

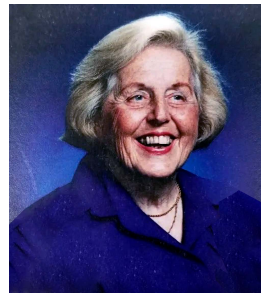
Volunteered at the Pontiac YMCA, Foreign Exchange
