

Golf Drive and Bagley Street Project



CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

April 3, 2024

Golf Drive

The City of Pontiac will begin construction operations on Golf Drive on April 8th. Westbound only traffic will be maintained between Old Telegraph Road and Bagley Street for the duration of the project. A detour for eastbound traffic will be posted as shown in the attached exhibit. The anticipated project completion is Spring of 2025.

Construction barrels will be placed along the centerline of Golf Drive while the Contractor works on the south half of the road for the first stage. A speed reduction down to 25 mph will be put in place to provide a safe work environment. One way and no left/no right turn signs will be placed along Golf Drive to prohibit vehicles from turning eastbound so please plan accordingly.

The Contractor will begin sawcutting the road to install storm pipe to improve drainage. The road crews will begin work on 4/15 to remove existing pavement starting on the east end of the project and working west.

Access will be maintained to all business and properties within the work zone throughout construction. In the event that a driveway or approach needs to be paved, the Contractor will pave one half at a time. If there is access elsewhere, the driveway or approach may be closed for a short duration. Owners located within the project limits will be notified prior to any scheduled disruptions to residential and commercial driveways.

Bagley Street

Construction on Bagley Street is scheduled to begin in May. Once materials are delivered and crews are ready to begin work, an additional notice will be sent out with a definitive date. Bagley Street will be completely closed during construction due to the large trenches needed in the roadway for sanitary sewer work.

No through traffic will be allowed on Bagley Street, but all businesses, churches, and other properties with driveways on Bagley Street will be maintained during construction. Please use the contact information included in this notice or ask for the on-site inspector if special arrangements are needed.

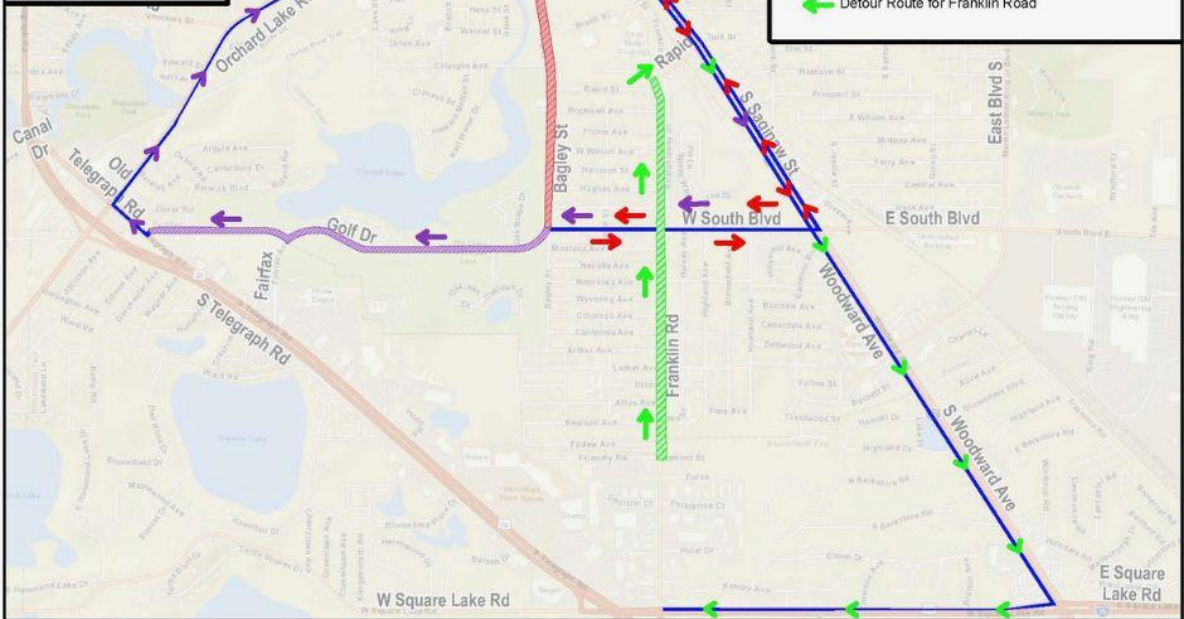
