

RESOLUTION NO. R-60-22

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A FEE SCHEDULE FOR THE "WATER UTILITY" CODE PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTERS 10A.35 OF THE PULLMAN CITY CODE.

WHEREAS, it is necessary for this City Council to adopt by Resolution a fee schedule for the "Water Utility" code, Chapter 10A.35 of the Pullman City Code; now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Pullman that the "Schedule of Monthly Water Service Rates and Additional and Special Charges Related to City Water Service" marked as Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, is adopted for the "Water Utility" Code pursuant to the provisions of the Pullman City Code Chapter 10A.35.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the fee schedule herein established shall be effective as of October 1, 2022.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that fee schedule herein established shall remain in effect until the effective date of any subsequent revisions of this fee schedule.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor, the Finance and Administrative Services Director, and their designees are each hereby authorized and directed to take such further action as may be appropriate in order to effect the purpose of this Resolution.

Pursuant to a Pullman City Council motion passed at the Council meeting on November 13, 2001, the charge for City park irrigation meters shall be one-half the regular irrigation meter charge. Turn off and turn on charges for City park irrigation meters are waived.

2. **OUTSIDE CITY** [P.C.C. 10A.35.010(1)(b)]

The rates and charges per month for City water used, consumed, withdrawn, or permitted to escape outside the city limits by each user and the Fire Line and General Facility Charges for each user are one and one-half times the rate which would be charged the same type of user in the city limits for the same service as set forth in subsections 1, 3, 4 and 13.

3. **FIRE LINES** [P.C.C. 10A.35.010(1)(c)]

Fire lines constructed to serve only fire protection systems within buildings may be connected without a meter; provided, however, that the following monthly rates will be charged to the user for:

4. **METER SIZE CHANGES, RELOCATIONS, OR GRADE CHANGES** [P.C.C. 10A.35.010(1)(d)]

The charge for changing the size of a meter, relocating a meter or changing the grade of a meter shall be on a time and material basis with a deposit * required to be paid to the City Finance Director prior to the work being performed. The deposit* required is as follows:

5. **METER TESTING CHARGE** [P.C.C. 10A.35.010(1)(e)]

The charge for customer-requested meter testing shall be \$36.40.

6. **PRESSURE REDUCING VALVE INSTALLATION FEE** [P.C.C. 10A.35.010(1)(f)]

The charge for installing pressure reducing valves shall be on a time and material basis with a deposit* required to be paid to the City Finance Director prior to the work being performed. The deposit* required is as follows:

7. **DEVELOPER-CONSTRUCTED EXTENSION FEE** [P.C.C. 10A.35.010(1)(g)]

The fee charged for services related to developer-constructed extensions shall be as follows:

<u>Estimated Cost of Water Line Extension*</u>	<u>Fee</u>
Up to \$50,000	2% of the estimated cost
\$50,001 and over	1% additional of the estimated cost over \$50,000

* Cost estimate shall be approved by the Director.

8. **DELINQUENT CHARGE INTEREST RATE** [RCW 35.67.200 and P.C.C. 10A.35.010(1)(h)]

The interest rate on delinquent charges shall be eight percent per annum computed on a monthly basis.

9. **TURN ON CHARGE - DELINQUENT PAYMENTS** [P.C.C. 10A.35.010(1)(i)]

Turn on charges for delinquent payments shall be \$52.00. If it is necessary to call an M&O employee back to work for the turn on, the charge shall be \$78.00.

10. **TURN OFF NOTIFICATION (Red Tag) CHARGE** [P.C.C. 10A.35.010(1)(j)]

Turn off notification (red tag) charge for past due payments shall be \$15.60.

11. **SPECIALLY-REQUESTED, NON-EMERGENCY TURN OFF OR TURN ON CHARGE** [P.C.C. 10A.35.010(1)(k)]

Specially requested, non-emergency turn off or turn on charge shall be \$26.00 for either action. If it is necessary to call an M&O employee back to work for the turn off or turn on, the charge shall be \$78.00.

12. **METER AND SERVICE INSTALLATION ON CHARGE** [P.C.C. 10A.35.010(1)(l)]

Every owner, lessee, or applicant shall, before property has water service, pay to the City Finance Director for this water connection on the following basis:

The charge for installing each service line and meter larger than one-inch shall be on a time and material basis, with a deposit* required to be paid to the City Finance Director prior to installation. The meter sizes and deposits* required are as follows:

13. **GENERAL FACILITY CHARGE (GFC) [P.C.C. 10A.35.010(1)(m)]**

Every owner, lessee, or applicant shall, before property has water service, pay to the City Finance Director for this water connection a general facility connection fee on the following basis:

When the number of units for a multi-unit customer (including mobile home parks) increases, the difference between the GFC for the revised multi-unit customer and the GFC for the existing multi-unit customer shall be paid to the City Finance Director. When a meter is upsized as the result of a remodel or demolition/reconstruction project, the difference between the GFC for the new meter and the GFC for the existing meter shall be paid to the City Finance Director.
