

RESOLUTION NO. R-9-22

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A FEE SCHEDULE FOR COLLECTION CHARGES PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF PULLMAN CITY CODE 1.100.010; RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. R-118-81; AND OTHER MATTERS RELATED THERETO.

WHEREAS, Pullman City Code 1.100.010 authorizes the Director of Finance and Administrative Services to levy a collection charge on the drawer of any unpaid bank draft, in accordance with a fee resolution established from time to time by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the actual fees charged to the City by its bank and payment processors, together with the administrative cost of processing unpaid bank drafts, exceed the collection charge set in Resolution No. 118-81; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance and Administrative Services recommends that the City Council adopt an updated fee schedule for collection charges in order to recover the actual costs to the City of such unpaid bank drafts; now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the city of Pullman as follows:

Section 1. The following fee schedule is adopted for collection charges on unpaid bank drafts from and after the effective date of this Resolution:

\$30.00 each time a bank draft is presented for payment but is not paid.

Section 2. Repealer. Resolution No. 118-81 is hereby repealed in its entirety as of the effective date of this Resolution. All other ordinances and resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed, and shall have no further force or effect.


Section 3. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Resolution should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Resolution.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective upon its adoption and shall remain in effect until amended or rescinded.


