Created by Oswego County Legislative Resolution #86 of 1971 and redefined by Resolution #152 of 1983, the Council is comprised of no more than 15 regular members, who serve at the pleasure of the Legislature Chairman for terms of “no more than 2 years” and ex-officio members who are heads of the county departments that deal with the environment. The Economic Development and Planning Committee makes recommendations for appointments. The Chairman of the Legislature makes the appointments and selects the member to serve as Chair of the EMC.
