City of Fulton Brownfield Opportunity Area (BOA) Program

What is the BOA program? How can the BOA program benefit the City of Fulton? What types of uses are best fit for these former industrial sites?

The City of Fulton is developing a BOA Nomination Study, which is step two of a three phase NYS BOA grant program which funds community studies for redevelopment and cleanup of brownfield sites. A brownfield is a former industrial site that may or may not be contaminated, however carries that perception regardless.

The BOA Program will allow Fulton to examine the threats posed by individual sites, and what type of remediation is necessary for redevelopment. The result of the Study will be a community driven vision for the revitalization of brownfield sites in Fulton and their surrounding areas.
