SUBJECT:

PURPOSE:

To accept from NYS DOT and subsequently disburse for appropriate public

SUMMARY: These are titled as "additional available funds" and have been authorized

for mobility management services. In 2022, The state and federal

governments require us to have an independent 3rd party "mobility manager" in order to receive rural transit funding. These funds will be utilized to reimburse the county for Mobility Management Services that were paid out

for 2022.


