EMERGENCY ORDER 2020-32**

STATE OF NEW YORK )  
COUNTY OF OSWEGO )      ss.:

I, **JAMES WEATHERUP**, as Chairman of the Legislature and Chief Executive of the County of Oswego, in accordance with a declaration of a State of Emergency issued by me on Sunday, March 15<sup>th</sup>, 2020 and renewed April 13<sup>th</sup>, 2020 and on May 11<sup>th</sup>, 2020, June 9<sup>th</sup>, 2020 and on July 7<sup>th</sup>, 2020 concerning the COVID-19 pandemic, and pursuant to the authority vested in me under New York State Executive Law § 24, **DO HEREBY RENEW** Emergency Order 2020-02, as amended by Emergency Order 2020-23, in its entirety for an additional period of five (5) days.

I further find and determine the COVID-19 pandemic continues to be an urgent, imminent or impending threat qualifying as a "disaster" as that term is defined under New York State Executive Law §20(2) and that the public health and safety of the citizens of the County of Oswego is imperiled thereby and that this emergency order is necessary and proper for the continuation of governmental operations and the provision of essential governmental services by the County of Oswego.


This order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in effect until expired or rescinded by me as the Chief Executive of the County of Oswego. This order may also be renewed in five (5) day increments.

Failure to obey this order is a criminal offense, punishable by law under New York State Executive Law §24(5).

I continue to direct that all officers, departments and agencies of the County of Oswego take whatever steps necessary to protect life and property, public infrastructure and provide whatever emergency assistance deemed necessary.
