1. The 25 legislative districts are hereby redistricted according to the final 2000 Census, as set forth in the attached maps marked Schedule A, as further described in Schedule B.
2. Said redistricting shall be implemented effective the next regular election in the odd numbered year next succeeding the effective date of this local law.
3. Attached hereto and marked as Schedule C is the mathematical distribution as to the legislative districts described herein, pursuant to the 2000 Census.
4. All other provisions of Local Law No. 1 of the year 1993 shall remain in full force and effect.
5. This local law shall be subject to permissive referendum pursuant to Section 24 of the Municipal Home Rule Law and Section 101 of the County Law and shall take effect as provided in said sections.

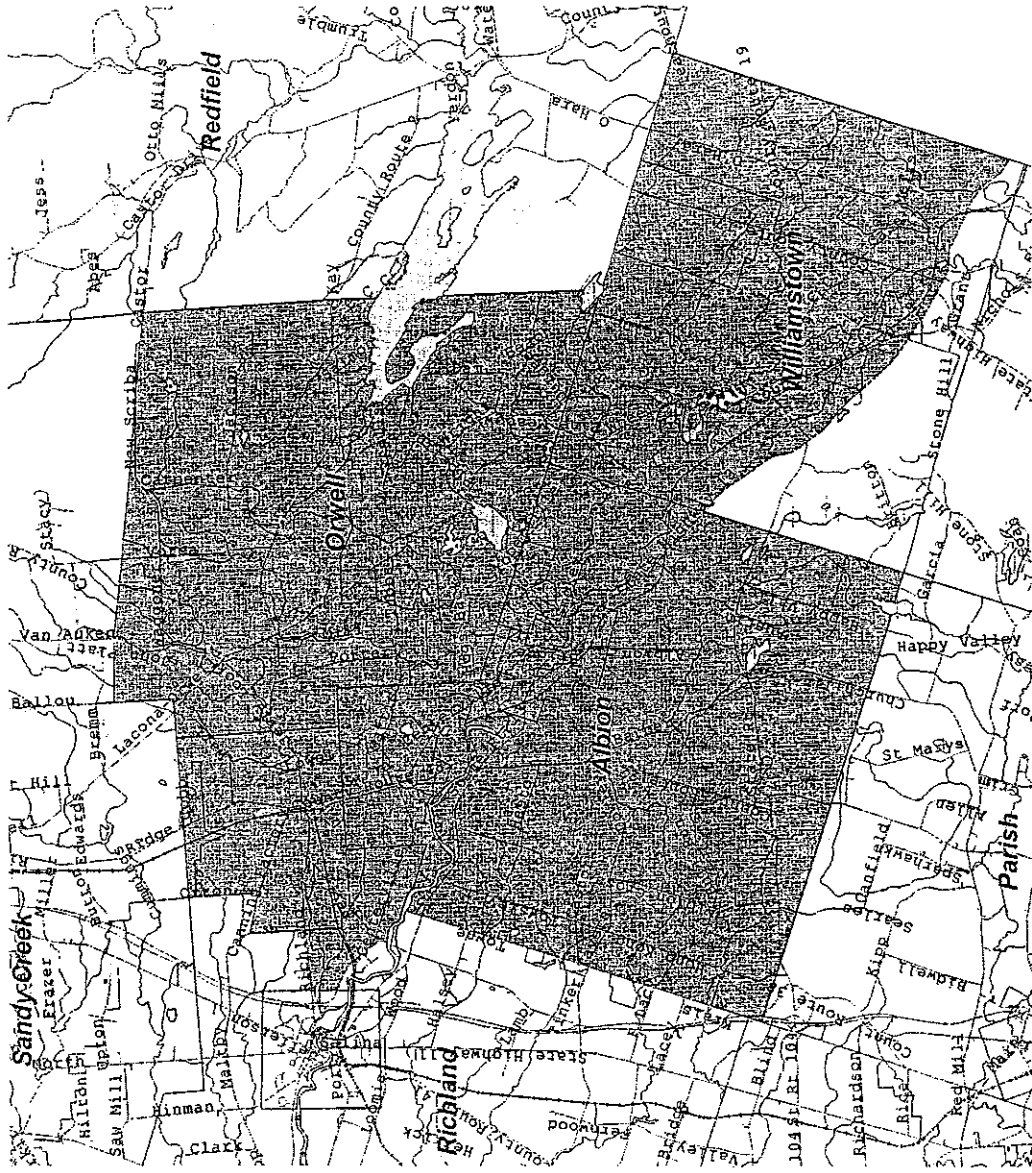

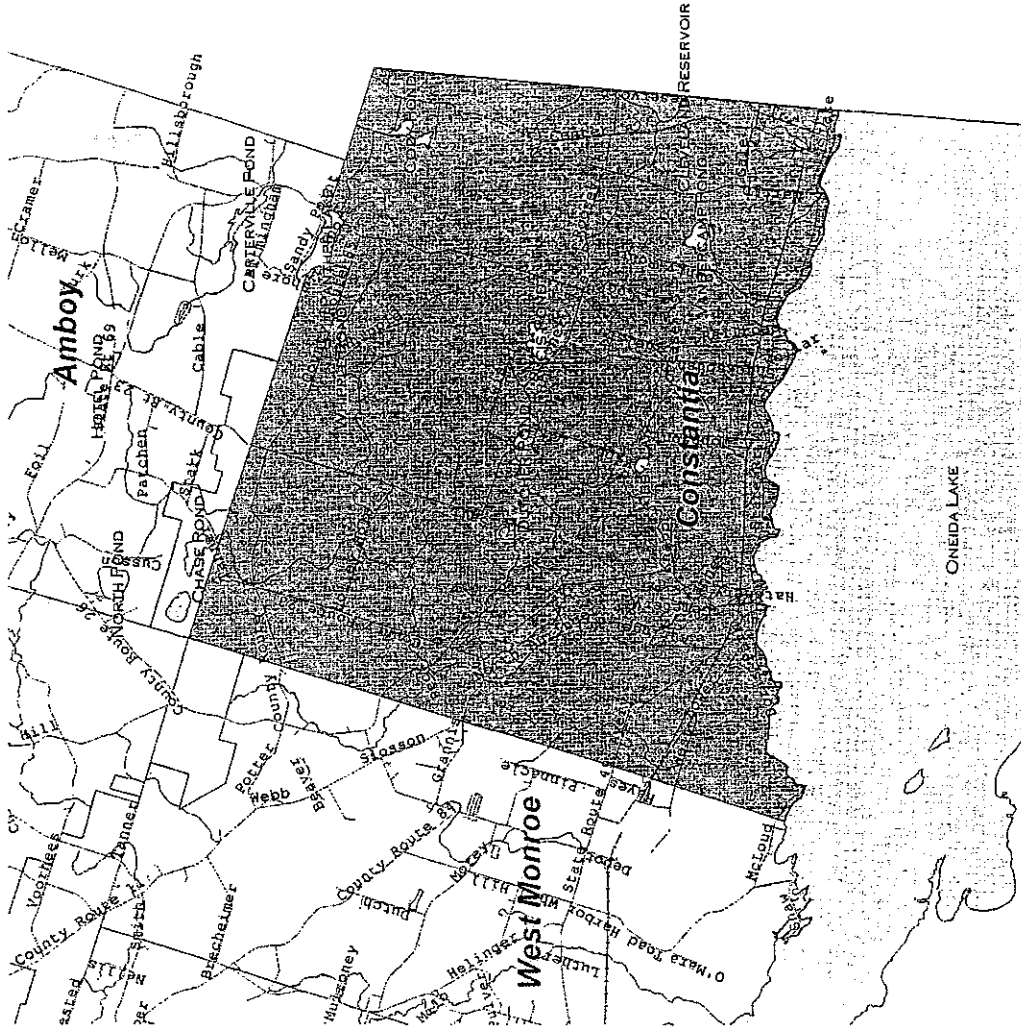

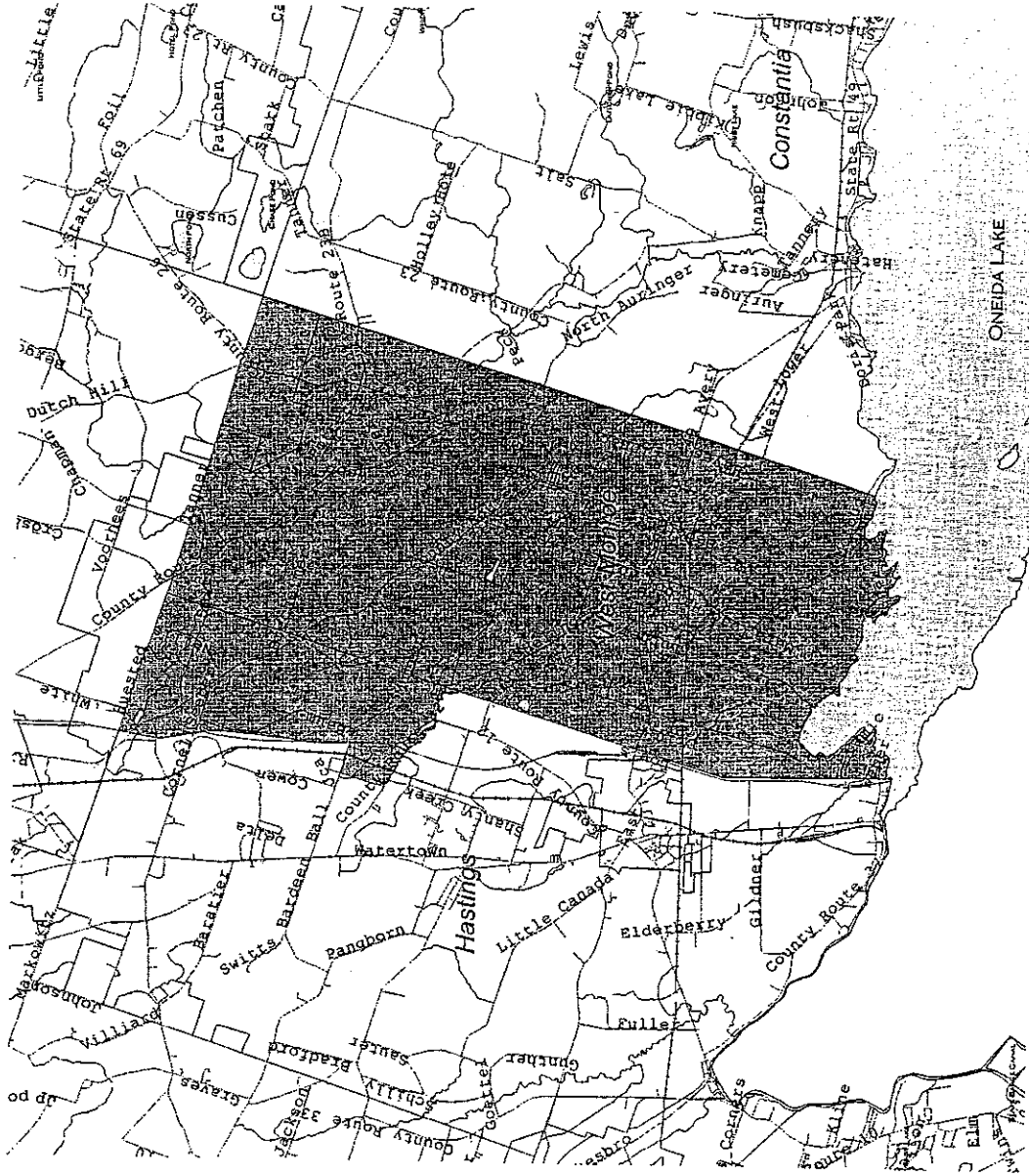

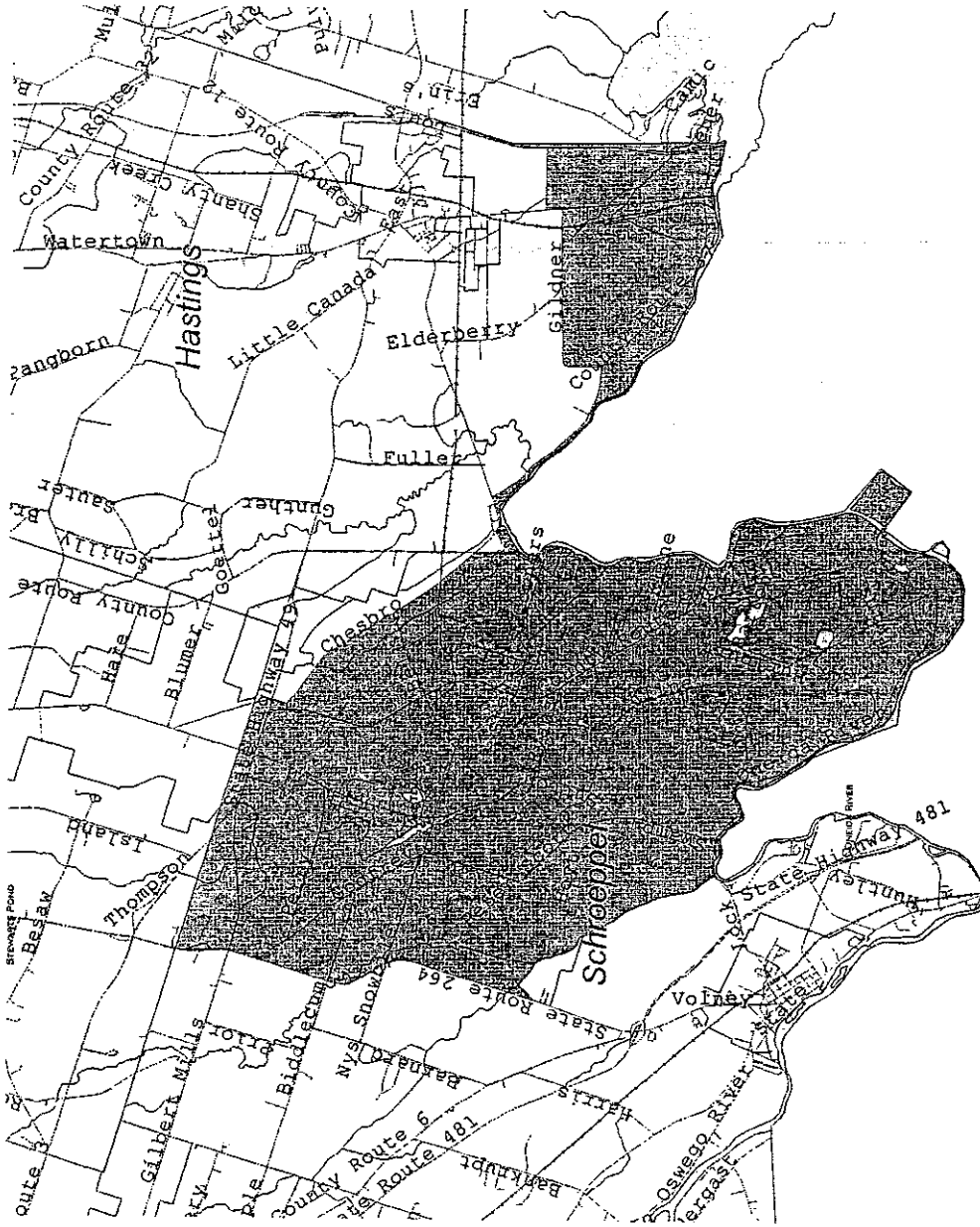

Cayuga County



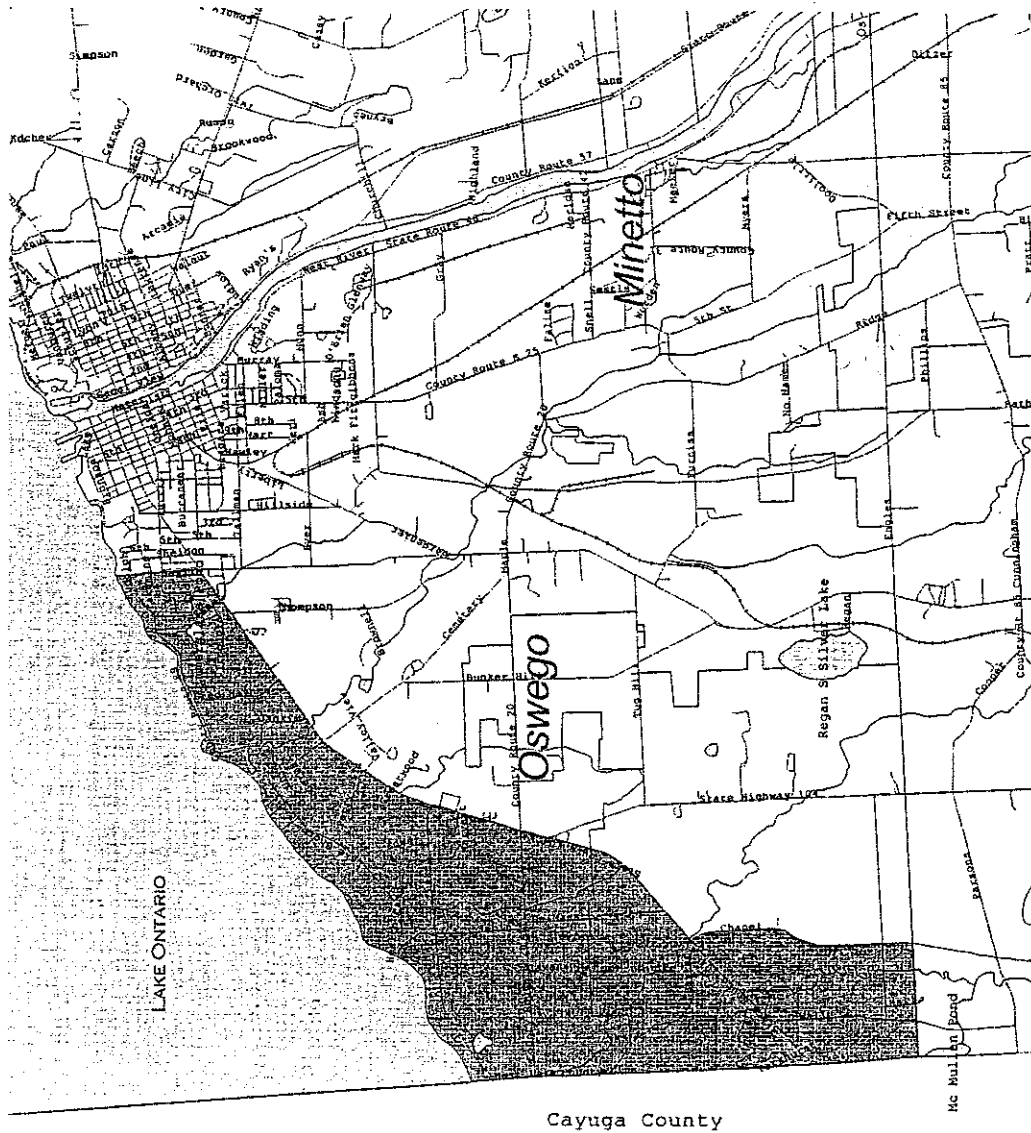

## SCHEDULE B

DISTRICT NO. 1 shall consist of the Towns of Sandy Creek, Boylston and Redfield.

DISTRICT NO. 2 shall consist of the Towns of Orwell, Albion, the portion of the Town of Williamstown north of the center line of NYS Route 13 and the following portion of the Town of Richland:

BEGINNING at the intersection of the northerly Town line and the centerline of the Orton Road; thence southerly along the centerline of the Orton Road to the centerline of the Canning Factory Road; thence westerly along the centerline of the Canning Factory Road to the centerline of Spring Brook Road; thence southerly along the centerline of Spring Brook Road to the centerline of Richland Road; thence westerly along the centerline of Richland Road to the Village of Pulaski east line; thence southeasterly along the Village of Pulaski east line to the centerline of County Route 2A; thence southeasterly along the centerline of County Route 2A to the Salmon River; thence easterly along the Salmon River to the Albion Town line; thence easterly, northerly and easterly along the Richland/Albion Town line to the Richland/Orwell Town line; thence northerly along the Richland/Orwell Town line to the Richland/Sandy Creek Town line; thence westerly along the Richland/Sandy Creek Town line to the point of beginning.

DISTRICT NO. 3 shall consist of the Town of Richland except for the portion of the Town contained in DISTRICT NO. 2.

DISTRICT NO. 8 shall consist of the Town of Palermo, the following portion of the Town of Hastings:

BEGINNING at a point in the centerline of Pangborn Road where it intersects with the westerly town line; then southerly along the town line to the southerly Town line; then east to the intersection of the Town line with County Route 33; then southerly along the centerline of County Route 33 and the Town line to the centerline of County Route 12; thence northerly and easterly along County Route 12 to the centerline of County Route 37; then southeasterly along the centerline of County Route 37 to Gildner Road; then north and east along the centerline of Gildner Road to Elderberry Lane Road; then north along the centerline of Elderberry Lane Road to County Route 12; thence westerly along the centerline of County Route 12 to the centerline of Fuller Road thence northerly along the centerline of Fuller Road to the centerline of NYS Route 49; thence westerly along the centerline of NYS Route 49 to the centerline of County Route 33; thence northerly along the centerline of County Route 33 to the centerline of Goettel Road thence northeasterly along the centerline of Goettel Road to the centerline of Gunther Road; thence northerly along the centerline of Gunther Road to the centerline of Little Canada Road; thence easterly along the centerline of Little Canada Road to the centerline of Route 49; thence easterly along the centerline of Route 49; to the west line of the Village of Central Square; thence north along the west line and east along the north line of the Village of Central Square to the centerline of Route 11; thence northerly along the centerline of US 11 to County Route 4; thence northerly and westerly along the centerline of County Route 4 to the centerline of Pine Tree Road; thence northerly along the centerline of Pine Tree Road to the centerline of Pangborn Road; thence westerly along the centerline of Pangborn Road to the point of beginning, AND

and continuing northerly along the Oneida River to Six Mile Creek; thence northerly along Six Mile Creek to the centerline of County Route 54; thence westerly along the centerline of County Route 54 to NYS Route 264; thence northerly along the centerline of County Route 264 to the Schroepfel Town line; then northwesterly along the Town line to the west Town line; thence southerly along said Town line to the point of beginning.

DISTRICT NO. 11 shall consist of the remainder of the Town of Volney not in DISTRICTS NO. 10.

DISTRICT NO. 12 shall consist of the portion of the Town of Schroepfel not in DISTRICTS NO. 8 and 10, and the following portion of the Town of Hastings:

BEGINNING at the intersection of the Town of Hastings west line with County Route 12; thence easterly along the centerline of County Route 12 to the centerline of County Route 37; thence southeasterly along the centerline of County Route 37 to the centerline of Gildner Road; thence north and east along the centerline of Gildner Road to the centerline of US Route 11; thence northerly along the centerline of US Route 11 to its intersection with Corporate Park Drive; thence easterly along Corporate Park Drive to the Hastings East Town line; thence southerly to the Oneida River/Oneida Lake; thence westerly along the Oneida River to the Town of Hastings west line; thence northerly along the Town of Hastings west line to the place of beginning.

DISTRICT NO. 13 shall consist of the Town of New Haven and the following portion of the Town of Scriba:

BEGINNING in the southeasterly corner of the Town of Scriba; thence westerly along the South Town line to Black Creek Tributary No. 7; thence northerly along Black Creek Tributary No. 7 to

DISTRICT NO. 16 shall consist of the following portion of the City of Oswego:

BEGINNING at the intersection of the centerlines of West Utica Street and West Sixth Street; thence west along the centerline of West Utica Street to the centerline of Fifth Avenue; thence southerly along the centerline of Fifth Avenue to the centerline of Tallman Street; thence westerly along the centerline of Tallman Street to the centerline of County Route 7 (also the west line of the City of Oswego); thence north along the west line of the City of Oswego to Lake Ontario; thence easterly along the shore of Lake Ontario as it winds and turns to the west bank of the Oswego River; thence southerly along the Oswego River to West Cayuga Street; thence westerly along West Cayuga Street to West Fourth Street; thence southerly along West Fourth Street to Mohawk Street; thence westerly along West Mohawk Street to West Sixth Street; thence southerly along West sixth Street to West Utica Street.

DISTRICT NO. 17 shall consist of the following portions of the City of Oswego and Town of Scriba:

BEGINNING at the intersection of the centerline of West Utica Street and the West Bank of the Oswego River; thence westerly along the West Utica Street to the centerline of West Sixth Street; thence northerly along the centerline of West Sixth Street to centerline of West Mohawk Street; thence easterly along the centerline of West Mohawk Street to its intersection with the centerline of West Fourth Street; thence northerly along the centerline of West Fourth Street to the centerline of West Cayuga Street; thence easterly along the centerline of West Cayuga Street to the west bank of the Oswego River; thence northerly along the west bank of the Oswego River to Lake Ontario; thence easterly along the shoreline of Lake Ontario as it winds and turns to Lakeview Road in the Town of Scriba; thence southerly along the centerline of Lakeview Road to the centerline of County Route 1; thence westerly along the centerline of County Route 1 to Walker Creek; thence



For the Town of Granby:

that portion north of County Route 85 and west of Ridge Road.

DISTRICT NO. 20 shall consist of the portion of the Town of Oswego:

situate north and west of US Route 104, Route 104A and Chapel Road.

DISTRICT NO. 21 shall consist of the Town of Hannibal, except that portion contained in DISTRICT NO. 19.

DISTRICT NO. 22 shall consist of the following portions of the City of Fulton and the Town of Granby:

BEGINNING at the intersection of the West Bank of the Oswego River with the centerline of West Broadway; thence westerly along the centerline of West Broadway to the centerline of West first Street; thence south along the centerline of West First Street to the centerline of Beech Street; thence westerly along the centerline of Beech Street to William Gillard Drive; thence north to the centerline of West Broadway; thence northwesterly along the centerline of West Broadway to the centerline of Lakeside Drive to Lake Neatahwanta; thence south along the shore of Lake Neatahwanta to the south line of the City of Fulton; thence easterly along the south line of the City of Fulton to the Conrail Railroad tracks; thence southerly along the Conrail Railroad to the Oswego County line; thence easterly along the Oswego County line to the West Bank of the Oswego River; thence northerly along the West Bank of the Oswego River to the point and place of beginning.

DISTRICT NO. 23 shall consist of the portion of the Town of Granby not contained in DISTRICTS NO. 19, 22 and 24.

DISTRICT NO. 25 shall consist of the portion of the City of Fulton located in the east side of the Oswego River not contained in DISTRICT NO. 24.
