**COUNTY OF OSWEGO
LOCAL LAW NUMBER 3 OF 2018
A LOCAL LAW AMENDING LOCAL LAW NUMBER 4 OF 2015
REGULATING AND PERMITTING ALL TERRAIN VEHICLE (ATV)
OPERATION ON CERTAIN COUNTY ROADS**

BE IT ENACTED by the County Legislature of the County of Oswego as follows:

SECTION 1. Purpose and Findings

The purpose of this Local Law is to open for travel by all-terrain vehicles certain portions of the County Road System pursuant to the authority granted in Section 2405 of the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York. This Legislature hereby finds and determines that the opening of certain County Roads to ATV use is necessary in order for ATVs to access trails adjacent thereto. This Legislature further finds that promoting opportunities for recreational use of all-terrain vehicles will stimulate the local economy and offer enjoyment to the citizens of the County and those tourists traveling in the area. This local law opens an additional segment of county roads to ATV use.

SECTION 2. Local Law Number 4 of 2015 is Amended

Local Law Number 4 of 2015 be and is hereby AMENDED to add an additional segment of county road under Section 4., entitled "Designated Roads" as follows:

- Segment 4. CR 26 beginning at a point 1.26 mile easterly from the intersection of CR 26 with CR 22 and then running westerly along CR 26, in the Town of Parish, approximately 4.42 miles to the intersection of SR 69 in the Town of Parish.

SECTION 3. Effective Date & Filing

This Local Law shall take effect May 1, 2018 upon filing with the Secretary of State. A certified copy of this local law shall also be filed with the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles pursuant to Vehicle and Traffic Law Section 2405.
