**RESOLUTION INCREASING PETTY CASH FUNDS IN THE OSWEGO MOTOR
VEHICLE OFFICE**

WHEREAS, this legislative body has previously authorized the establishment of petty cash funds, pursuant to §371 of the County Finance Law; and

WHEREAS, the authorized amount in the Oswego Motor Vehicle Office is now \$500; and

WHEREAS, an increase in the petty cash funds is necessary for the Oswego Motor Vehicle Office to add five cash drawers and increase the amount of startup fees as the result of remodeling and increased staffing.

NOW, upon the recommendation of the Government and Consumer Affairs Committee of this body, and with the approval of the Finance and Personnel Committee; be it

RESOLVED, that the Oswego County Legislature hereby authorizes and increases petty cash funds in the Oswego Motor Vehicle Office to \$1,500; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the administration of said petty cash funds shall be in accordance with the provisions of §371 of the County Finance Law; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this resolution shall be effective upon adoption and the Clerk of the Legislature shall provide a copy of said resolution to the County Treasurer as his authorization to increase said accounts.

**RESOLUTION OPPOSING THE GOVERNOR'S PROPOSED "ACCELERATED
RENEWABLE ENERGY GROWTH AND COMMUNITY BENEFIT ACT"**

By Legislator David Holst:

WHEREAS, Governor Cuomo has proposed the "Accelerated Renewable Energy Growth and Community Benefit Act," which, despite its name, would negatively impact renewable energy host communities by removing local home-rule rights and controls, and by fast-tracking wind and solar projects that could potentially harm local economies and environments; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Act was added to the State Budget proposal only after budget hearings were completed, giving State Legislators insufficient time to examine the proposal and identify its negative consequences; and

WHEREAS, although the inclusion of renewable energy sources within the State's energy plan, and the streamlining of bureaucratic processes are commendable initiatives, the proposed Act goes too far by essentially gutting Article 10 and empowering the State to force medium and large wind and solar projects into local communities that don't want them; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Act would:

- Create a new State bureaucracy to handle the permitting and siting of wind and solar projects, which would not be responsive or accountable to the local communities impacted, and which would be susceptible to influence from deep-pocket domestic and foreign energy corporations and their lobbyists; and
- Override and nullify County Local Laws and Town/City/Village Ordinances that were adopted by local governments to responsibly guide development of energy projects within their jurisdictions, in accordance with the wishes of their citizens and businesses; and
- Remove the voices of the local citizens and their elected representatives from the siting process; and
- Endanger the ability of local governments to receive fair property tax revenues from renewable energy facilities; and
- Establish undefined and unquantified host community benefits and create workforce training programs, "subject to available funding," which are geared toward non-existent green energy jobs.
- Allow corporations whose proposals are already going through the Article 10 process to opt into the new fast-track process, thereby avoiding legitimate

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and valid objections and concerns of the local impacted communities and circumventing vital processes that that hold project proposers accountable; and

WHEREAS, as an example of this proposed Act's deficiencies, a proposal that could be fast-tracked to great detriment of Oswego County's economy and environment, is Atlantic Wind LLC's proposed 350 megawatt Mad River Wind Farm in the Town of Worth in Jefferson County and the Town of Redfield in Oswego County - a project that would clear cut great swaths of 20,000 acres of pristine Tug Hill forest recreation areas, and place in danger of contamination the headwaters of the Salmon River, one of North America's top sport fisheries and the region's economic driver.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oswego County Legislature opposes the misleadingly-named Accelerated Renewable Energy Growth and Community Benefit Act, and urges the New York State Legislature to reject the proposal; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the Oswego County Legislature shall forward copies of this resolution to Governor Andrew M. Cuomo, Senator Patty Ritchie, Assembly Minority Leader Will Barclay, Assemblyman Brian Manktelow, Redfield Town Supervisor Tanya Yerdon, Jefferson County Chairman Robert Gray, and the New York State Association of Counties.

WHEREAS, it is important that the state provide a witness to a crime the ability to prevent personally identifiable information from being shared with the defense or the accused, if they feel that their safety or the safety of their loved ones is jeopardized through the reporting of such information; and

WHEREAS, S.7133 would allow a witness to a crime a mechanism to provide justification as to why they do not want their personal information to be shared with defense counsel or the individual(s) accused of having committed a crime,

COUNTY OF OSWEGO LOCAL LAW NUMBER 1 OF 2020
A LOCAL LAW OPTING OUT OF THE TAX
EXEMPTION UNDER REAL PROPERTY TAX LAW §487**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE COUNTY OF OSWEGO AS
FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE PURPOSE AND INTENT

New York State Real Property Tax Law §487 as enacted exempted from taxation certain Solar, Wind and Farm Waste energy systems. That provision was subsequently amended by Chapter 336 of the Laws of 2017 to expand the tax exemption to include additional energy systems such as micro-hydroelectric energy systems, fuel cell electric generating systems, micro-combined heat and power generating systems and electric energy storage systems, all as are more fully stated in RPTL §487. While the County Legislature wishes to encourage residents and businesses to utilize these modern and alternative forms of energy systems, the legislature does not desire to undermine or adversely affect the tax revenues that may result from increased assessments as a result of these improvements. Further, there are significant existing hydroelectric, nuclear and other generational assets within the County of Oswego which already are on the tax rolls, employ residents and face transmission constraints to market which must compete with new energy systems covered by RPTL §487.

SECTION 2. STATUTORY AUTHORITY

New York State Real Property Tax Law §487(8)(2) states that a county by local law may provide that no exemption under the said legislation shall be applicable within its jurisdiction with respect to any energy system covered by said statutory provision which began construction upon the effective date of the local law.

SECTION 3. ENACTMENT

The County of Oswego desires to exercise its statutory right under RPTL §487 8(a) by enacting this local law and does hereby “opt out” of the provisions of Real Property Tax Law §487, including the amendment and/or expansion thereof provided by Chapter 336 of the Laws of 2017, such that no tax exemption under RPTL §487 only shall be applicable within the County of Oswego with respect to any of the following:

1. Solar energy system;
2. Wind energy system;
3. Farm waste energy system;
4. Micro-hydroelectric energy system;
5. Fuel cell electric generating systems;

6. Micro-combined heat and power generating systems;
7. Electric energy storage systems;
8. Any other energy system intended to be covered by or apply to RPTL §487 or by Chapter 336 of the Laws of 2017 or any amendment, alteration or expansion thereto;

and provided the construction of the any of the above listed energy systems began on or after the effective date of this law.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY

If the provisions of any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, subdivision, clause, phrase or provision of this Local Law shall be, for any reason, held or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such order or judgment shall not affect or invalidate the validity and enforceability of the remainder of any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, subdivision, clause, phrase or provision of this Local Law.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Local Law shall be effective upon filing with the office of the Secretary of State.

SECTION 6. ADDITIONAL FILING REQUIREMENTS.

The Clerk of the Legislature shall cause a certified copy of this Local Law to be filed with the NYS Commissioner of Taxation and Finance and with the President of the New York State Energy Research and Development Authority as provided for in RPTL §487(8).
