INTERMUNICIPAL AGREEMENT

This Agreement, made this ____ day of September, 2016, by and between the County of Oswego, a municipal corporation with offices at 46 E. Bridge Street, Oswego, NY 13126, (the "County"), and the City of Oswego, a municipal corporation of the State of New York, with offices at West Oneida Street, Oswego, NY 13126, (the "City").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the County of Oswego and the City of Oswego both operate law enforcement agencies namely the Oswego County Sheriff's Office and the Oswego City Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the County of Oswego has, heretofore, contracted with Motorola Solutions, Inc. (Spillman) to provide certain software to the county and other agencies within the County of Oswego; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oswego wishes to enter into an agreement with Motorola Solutions, Inc. on certain terms to utilize the same software and technology as other county agencies; and

WHEREAS, this will promote efficiencies between and among local governments and allow all county agencies to utilize the same platform and data; and

WHEREAS, an intermunicipal agreement is both necessary and desirable,

NOW, THEREFORE, it is mutually covenanted and agreed by and between parties hereto as follows:

1. The City of Oswego has or will execute the annexed Shared Agency Agreement between Motorola Solutions, Inc. and the City of Oswego Police Department (copy annexed hereto) .
2. Upon execution of same, the City of Oswego hereby agrees to pay to Motorola Solutions, Inc. directly the sum of \$201,340.12 for pre-paid maintenance covering years 2-10.
3. Upon execution of same, the County of Oswego hereby agrees to pay Motorola Solutions, Inc., directly as a partial inducement to the City of Oswego joining this software platform the sum of \$188, 234.30 in accordance with Motorola's payment terms. This will cover related expenses to bring the City of Oswego online, to-wit: Integrated Software (Hub, CAD) \$174,960.78, Hardware \$2,285, Professional Services \$34,123.98, Warranty/ 1st year maintenance and support (Included) less discount (\$23,135.46).
4. Severability: If any term or provision of this Agreement shall be held invalid or unenforceable, the remainder of this Agreement shall not be affected thereby and every other term and provision of this Agreement shall be valid and enforced to the fullest extent permitted by law.

5. Additional Clauses as Required by Law. The parties hereto understand and agree that each and every provision of law and clause required by law to be inserted in this Agreement shall be deemed to have been inserted herein, and if through mistake or inadvertence such provision is not inserted, said clause shall be deemed to have been inserted and shall have the full force and effect of law.
6. Entire Agreement. This Agreement represents the entire and integrated agreement between the County of Oswego and the Contractor and the supersedes all prior negotiations, representations or agreements wither written or oral. This Agreement may be amended only by written instrument signed by both the County of Oswego and the City of Oswego.
7. Choice of Law. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of New York.

RESOLVED, that the governing body of the municipality delegates signing authority to execute the Master Contract and any amendments thereto any required deed of easement, and any other certifications to the individual(s) who hold(s) the following elected or appointed municipal office(s) or employment position title(s); County of Oswego Chairman of the Legislature.
