**RESOLUTION DESIGNATING POWERS AND AUTHORITY OF ACTING
HIGHWAY SUPERINTENDENT IN AND FOR THE COUNTY OF OSWEGO**

WHEREAS, the position of Highway Superintendent will become vacant on March 24, 2022 due to the retirement of the incumbent; and

WHEREAS, the Deputy Highway Superintendent has resigned; and

WHEREAS, the appointment of an Acting Highway Superintendent in and for the County of Oswego under Highway Law §100 is both necessary and desirable for continuity of operations in the Oswego County Highway Department and general oversight of the department, its employees and equipment; and

WHEREAS, Christopher N. Baldwin, P.E. has agreed to act as Interim Highway Superintendent, while performing his duties as Highway Engineer, until a successor can be found and appointed, or until July 31, 2022,

NOW, THEREFORE, upon motion of the Infrastructure and Facilities Committee of this body, it is hereby

RESOLVED, that Christopher N. Baldwin, P.E. of the Town of Mexico be and is hereby granted all powers and authority to equal those of Acting Highway Superintendent in and for the County of Oswego, while maintaining his current position of Highway Engineer, effective March 24, 2022 to serve until a successor can be found and appointed, or until July 31, 2022; and, it is further

RESOLVED, that his annual salary shall be the same as the outgoing Highway Superintendent, or \$119,206.00, during the time period he performs duties as Acting Highway Superintendent; and, it is further

RESOLVED, that Christopher N. Baldwin shall have immediate authority to fill, and backfill, any current vacancies within the Highway Department; and, it is further

RESOLVED, that upon the appointment of a successor Highway Superintendent, Christopher N. Baldwin, P.E. shall revert back to performing only those duties of his current position of Highway Engineer and step/grade pay under the Oswego County Professionals Association collective bargaining agreement.
