Hazard Mitigation Planning

Barton&Loguidice

- Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000
 - New guidelines for State multi-hazard mitigation planning
 - New requirements for local multi-hazard mitigation planning
 - Basis for Hazard Mitigation Grant Program funding
 - Emphasis on Multi-Hazard, Multi-Jurisdiction Plans
 - Planning steps outlined in 44 CFR Part 201.6



Hazard Mitigation Planning

Barton&Loguidice

- Oswego County received a grant through disaster relief (DR) FEMA 4480 to update their 2020 Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan (HMP)
 - 2020 HMP: https://www.oswegocounty.com/departments/public_safety/emergency_management/hazard_mitigation.php
- Hazard mitigation planning develops long-term actions that aim to reduce:
 - Loss of life
 - Number/severity of injuries
 - Property & natural resource damages

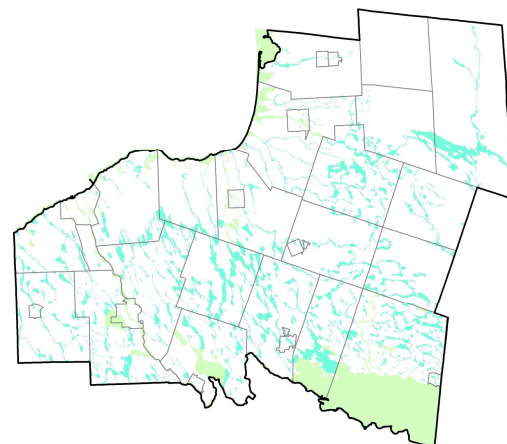
- Review and update information from the 2020 HMP

 - More specific and useful information
 - Appended to main plan document
 - Easier to navigate and update

 - Update hazard analysis
 - Temporary & permanent housing locations for each jurisdiction
 - Floodplain review for critical infrastructure
 - Summarize new development
 - Status update for 2020 mitigation actions, develop a mitigation item for each hazard identified

- Natural Hazards
 - Flood, Severe Thunderstorm/Windstorm, Ice Storm, Ice Jam, Extreme Temperatures, Drought, Wildfire, Avalanche, Coastal Storm, Earthquake, Hurricane, Infestation, Landslide, Severe Winter Storm, Tornado

Hazard Analysis Criteria				
Score	Extent	Onset	Impact	Frequency
1	One location	Days of warning	Minor damages/ injuries	Rare
2	Several locations	Hours of warning	Moderate damages/ injuries	Infrequent
3	Large area	No warning	Severe damages/ injuries	Regular

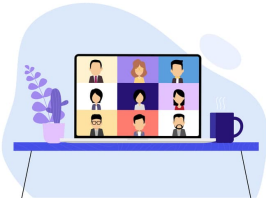

 - Utility Failure
 - Terrorism
 - Epidemic
 - Transportation Accident
 - Radiological (Fixed Site)
 - Water Supply Contamination

Jurisdiction Participation Approach

Barton&Loguidice

- Individual meetings with B&L
 - One primary meeting and follow-up as needed
 - Virtual, in person, or hybrid

 - Local elected officials
 - Town/Village board members
 - Town/Village clerks
 - Planning board members
 - Highway/DPW superintendent
 - Water/sewer department staff
 - Floodplain administrator
 - Code enforcement
 - Local fire and police department officials

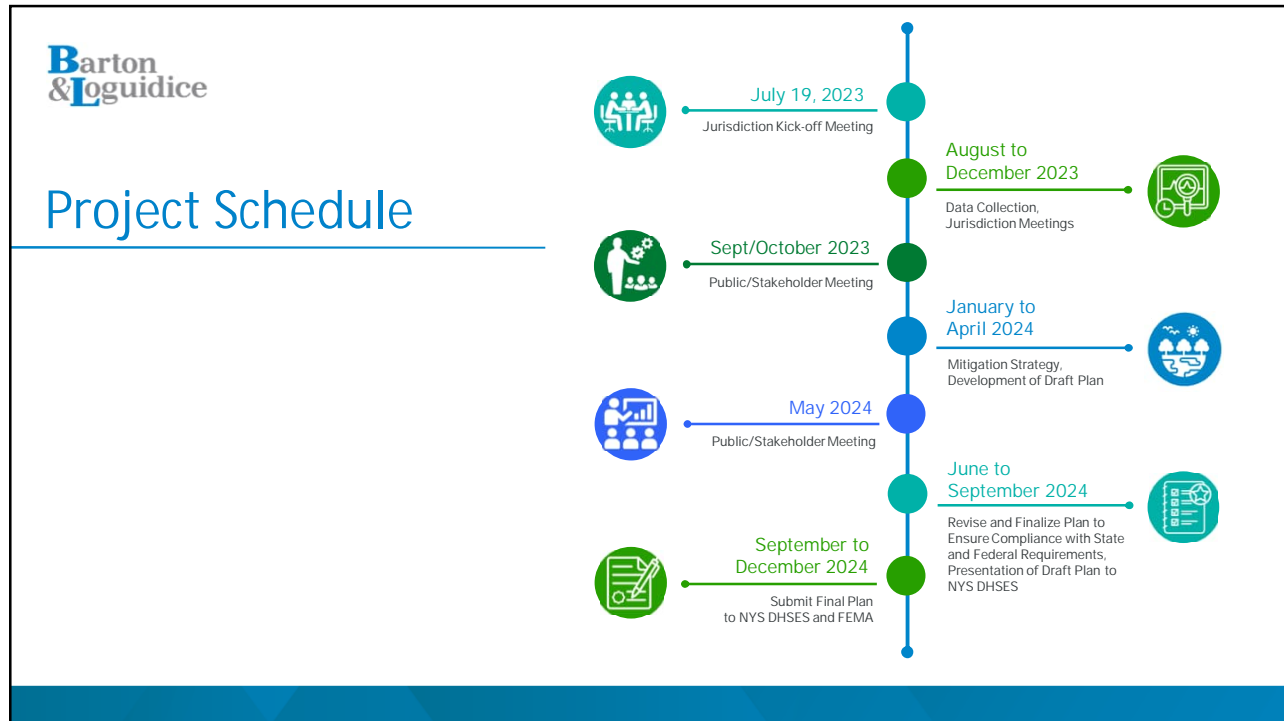
