The City of Roseville continues to monitor the unfolding COVID-19 outbreak and is taking appropriate actions to protect the health and well-being of our residents and employees. We expect to receive regular updates from the Michigan Department of Public Health, the Macomb County Health Department and the Center for Disease Control and Prevention. Credit for programs may be issued if rescheduling is not a possibility. All drop-in related programs are also canceled until further notice.

SMART Bus Transportation

SMART Bus Transportation will only be available for those who have pre-scheduled doctors' appointments. No new appointments may be made until further notice.

Youth & Adult Sport Leagues

All youth and adult sport leagues are canceled until further notice. Rescheduling of games and practices will be determined at a later date. Credit for leagues may be issued if rescheduling is not a possibility. Team photos are also postponed until further notice.

Adult & Youth Open Gym


Canceled for the remainder of the season.
