Coronavirus Relief Water and Plumbing Repair (CRF)

Objective: Provide water repairs to mitigate the spread of Covid-19 by ensuring low-income households have access to water for washing and disinfecting surfaces. Ensure every eligible home has access to hot and cold water and at least one functioning toilet, shower/bath, kitchen faucet and laundry tub.

Requirements: The household income must be at or below 200% of the federal poverty level. All clients must provide identification to receive services. Clients must also provide documentation that shows they live at the property.

Information will be gathered to determine the level of need of each client. Clients with any of the determined points are vulnerable amid the pandemic and may receive services. Client's level of need is determined by the priority points.
