RESOLUTION EXTENDING A LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY INCLUDING  
TEMPORARILY CLOSING BUILDINGS, RESTRICTING OPERATIONS OF THE  
CITY OF ROSEVILLE AND GRANTING EMERGENCY AUTHORITY TO THE MAYOR  
IN CONSULTATION WITH THE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT COORDINATOR AND  
CITY MANAGER TO TAKE OTHER EMERGENCY MEASURES AS A RESULT  
OF COVID19 A/K/A CORONAVIRUS EPIDEMIC

**TO:** DIRECTOR, MACOMB COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AND COMMUNICATIONS - COMMANDING OFFICER- EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AND HOMELAND SECURITY DIVISION, MICHIGAN STATE POLICE; DISTRICT 2 NORTH EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AND HOMELAND SECURITY DIVISION COORDINATOR; ALL CITIZENS, EMPLOYEES, OFFICIALS, OTHER INTERESTED PARTIES

At a Special Meeting of the City Council of the City of Roseville, held in the council chambers, 29777 Gratiot Avenue, Roseville, Michigan on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of March, 2020, commencing at 8:30 a.m.

PRESENT: Mayor Robert Taylor, Mayor Pro Tem Jan Haggerty, Councilpersons, Colleen McCartney, Catherine Haugh, Bill Shoemaker, Charles Frontera and Steve Wietecha.

**WHEREAS**, recently a virus-related disease referred to as COVID19, also known as, the Coronavirus, has been reported with documented cases throughout the world, including the State of Michigan and Macomb County; and

**WHEREAS**, the Governor of the State of Michigan commencing Thursday, March 12, 2020, with Executive Order 2 has issued Executive Orders 2-8 relating to the subject including closing all K-12 schools, numerous colleges and universities restricting face-to-face instruction, closing places of assemblage, including bars and restaurants and otherwise seeking to drastically limit close proximity of members of the public with each other; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor has the authority under the City of Roseville Ordinances and the Michigan Emergency Management Act, to declare a local state of emergency and has issued such declaration March 17, 2020, which is subject to approval by the City Council within seven (7) days of said declaration;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, upon motion by Councilman Steven Wietecha, supported by Councilman Bill Shoemaker, the City of Roseville local state of emergency issued by the Mayor on March 17, 2020 is hereby approved and extended for a period of ninety (90) days or until further action of the City Council;

**IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED** that until April 21, 2020 at 11:59p.m., or less, if modified by action of the City Council, all buildings owned and/or operated by the City which are accessible to members of the public are hereby closed to the public and alternative means of doing City business will be provided;

**IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED** that the regular City Council meeting scheduled for March 24, 2020, is hereby canceled, said business to be included on the agenda at that meeting having been included as part of the agenda for the Council meeting held on this date and pursuant to the local state of emergency;

**IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED** that the regular City Council meeting scheduled for Tuesday, April 14, 2020 at 6:30p.m. is rescheduled for Tuesday, April 21, 2020 immediately following the City of Roseville ZBA meeting scheduled at 5:30p.m. that same date;

**IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED** that nonessential personnel and departments as determined by the City Manager will be directed to work from home or on a limited basis in the City offices to reduce contact with other employees, as needed;

**IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City Council grants to the Mayor, in consultation with the Emergency Management Coordinator and the City Manager, the authority to take any other emergency measures as a result of the COVID19 a/k/a Coronavirus pandemic or other Executive Orders issued by the Governor of Michigan or the President of the United States.

Any resolutions in conflict are repealed only to the extent necessary to give full force and effect to the foregoing provisions.

This Resolution is deemed severable. Should any provision, clause, word or sentence be deemed unenforceable, the remainder shall remain in full force and effect.
