

Public Works Committee Meeting Minutes April 24th, 2017

Attendance –Ms. Zuchowski-Eckel, Mr. Ruse, Mr. Kolb

1. The state bid for road salt is due May 10th, 2017. Mr. Kolb would like to order 600 tons. With what we have in storage left over from this winter, that will give us about 1200 ton, which is what we've been averaging since 2005.
2. At a previous Public Works committee meeting the committee voted unanimously to stop MSG from working on the construction standards and right of way work standards and to do it in house through Mr. Heban's office instead. The committee would like MSG to turn over all of the files to Mr. Heban. Ms. Eckel followed up with Mr. Heban to see if he had received any of the files, as of April 24th, he had not.
3. The committee discussed resuming design projects that have been put on hold. These are the storm water and paving design in the Eagle Point colony and the storm water plans completed for the portion of Colony Road between Hillside and Eagle Point that was put on hold while we were waiting for the sanitary sewer work and pump station abandoning project to be complete.

The committee would like to go out for qualifications and select an engineer or engineers for design of the Colony Roads, Eagle Point west of Colony, Colony South of Eagle Point, North of Hillside and East Hillside and Hillview for three phases of full depth reclamation in these areas and storm sewer on Hillview.
