

Public Works Committee Meeting Minutes

Sept 4, 2019, 7:30 am (called to order at 7:41)

Colony Subdivision

- the project is getting underway with tree work the week of Sept. 9th, and excavation work beginning the week of the 16th. All underground first, with paving to follow in the spring.
- NWWSD has indicated there are potential sump pump and downspout connections into the sanitary sewer, that at some point they will have to force the property owners to relocate to the new/upgraded storm lines. No timeline on this yet.

Vineyard/Groce and Colony Rd (Hillside to Eagle Pt) Assessment cost determination model

- the committee reviewed and motioned (Bob D; 2nd Robert R) to adopt the assessment policy
- Administration to have the policy for council Monday

Colony/Lime City/SR 65 roundabout

- OPWC funding application will be submitted Sept 6th in the amount of \$175K

Crossroads Review

- MSG updated the committee that currently any issues addressed in the 1999/2000 plan are adequately addressed.
- Also, with the City's new Storm Water Ordinance, all drainage increase should be dealt with on site.
- The committee discussed a pending development that would require the City to clean/dredge the southern drainage swale along W Deimling Rd. Public Works & Administration will secure costs. Part of this clean out will include looking at obstructions in the drainage swale on E Deimling near the Sheet Metal Union.
- The committee asked the Administration to reach out to the County to determine cost and schedule for them to tar/chip Deimling (potentially yet this year) to provide for a short term improvement of the road surface.

NWWSD New Projects

- Tom Stalter NWWSD is still waiting on the contractor's schedule for the Helen Drive Work/restoration north off of Eagle Point Rd.
- Tom S indicated that the Eagle Point Rd Sewer Replacement project is tentatively scheduled to begin the week of Sept 16th.

Sidewalks near Rec Center

- Committee discussed the need to level several sections of sidewalk in front of the Rec Center. This should be done for people just walking, Stroll the Street walkers, Rec center patrons, and Senior Center visitors. Tyler will secure pricing for concrete pumping/leveling.

795/Lime City Intersection – the committee voiced its displeasure with the quality of the road work done by the School District near the new elementary school. Ed C. mentioned that the Port Authority is reviewing upgrades to the intersection which would include both north and south – north impacting the work the school just did, and south having heavy involvement with the OTC overpass.

795/Cross Roads Blvd Interchange – Ed C mentioned that we will be talking about access/restrictions as the property owner explores development ideas at the SE corner of the interchange – more to come on this.

Eagle Point Rd (Colony to River) – the committee asked MSG to explore a temporary 10 yr fix for the road, such as a simple overlay. Currently funding not possible for a \$1 million road/curb improvement project.

Stop Sign on Glenwood at Beech – Bob D motioned, Robert R 2nd, and passed motion to remove the stop sign on Glenwood at Beech at the same time the Bacon Street traffic re-direction project is implemented.
