

Public Works Committee Minutes

May 13, 2020, 11:00 via ZOOM

Committee – R. Ruse, R. Densic, Jerry Staczek, Allyson Murray

Guests – Neil MacKinnon, Kevin Heban, Neil Materni (Poggemeyer), J Colapietro

City Trash Pick Up Service – the committee revisited the bids due to some questions raised on the clarifications/exceptions the bidders noted in their respective bids.

- Two bidders submitted, Waste Management [current vendor] and Republic
- Five options – 1. current service; 2. current trash, but no recycling; 3. yard waste program; 4. stand alone/individual recycling; 5. One time a year annual cleanup; plus fees for public building containers
- Committee wants the Administration to clarify the total annual dollars from each vendor to ascertain that we are evaluating correctly
- Option 1 is \$2M Republic vs \$3.1 for Waste Management
- Option 2 is \$1.47M Republic vs \$2.1M for WM
- Assuming no issues with our assumptions on total cost, the Committee agreed to stay with their prior recommendation to Council : change vendor to Republic and go with no recycling; committee felt that Republic's exceptions were minor
- Allyson is reviewing some standalone recycling options and will have those for the next Council meeting

Vineyard/Groce – The committee did a quick review of the project.

- Bid opening set for 11:00 on May 21st
- \$392,000 Engineer's Estimate
- Estimate a 40-60 day construction period; period of performance runs thru Nov, 2020
- With five different contractors working in Rossford currently, we are hoping for healthy bids
- Committee asked a clarifying question on the assessments – letters were sent out May 5th – drives over 9' will have the extra footage assessed to the property owner
