### AGENDA

1. Bass Pro Boulevard Resurfacing - TIF monies will be used to pay for the project. The Ordinance will be on the 6/10 meeting agenda to award. Gerken was the low bidder and recommended by Feller and Fitch, the engineers on the project.

2. Bridge over I-75 on Lime City is scheduled for a 6/10 closure. It will be closed for approximately 120 days.

The bridge will be lettered with "City of Rossford" letters in the fencing. It will be black fence with grey letters. The lettering is Rossford's only cost contribution to the project. This Ordinance will be on the 6/10 meeting agenda.

3. Windsor/Hoffman project - Sidewalks on Hoffman should start mid July for the stretch of sidewalks from Jennings to Wondsor. The portion from Windsor to Hannum is being pushed to next year. Expected cost is in the \$15,000 to \$20,000 range. Tetra Tech is developing a road repair cost for that stretch as well.

NWWSD has agreed to replace the Waterline on Hoffman prior to the resurfacing of the roadway.

Windsor and Jennings paving will be the 1st or 2nd Week of August, with a completion date of mid to late August.

A premium grass seed mix will be used in the restoration.

4. Jennings Road project - an open house for residents similar to the one dinner for the Windsor project will be held so the public can view that plans and residents can voice concerns.

Hillcrest and Riverside will be completed at the end of the Jennings project in 2025.

The Jennings Road project will be the final project of the current 5 year plan. Tetra Tech is currently doing road condition grading for the next 5 year pavement replacement plan.

5. The city is looking for grants for storm water improvements for Hillsdale.

6. Sidewalk replacement on Hannum - A number of residents expressed concerns for the number of broken sidewalks on Hannum. The city will get estimate for the repairs and then the committee will discuss further replacement plans. Council Woman Zuchowski- Eckel would like to start a yearly sidewalk replacement project to encourage citizens to repair their sidewalks.

8. Tetra Tech was at the meeting to answer the committee's questions about the Roundabout at Superior and Bergin street. Conceptual ideas for landscape architecture, done by The Edge, as part of the restoration of the area were also discussed.

9. Updates on the Buck-Glenwood Roundabout were given.

11. The committee discussed EV Charging Stations - after a plan with possible locations was presented to the administration. The committee agreed that they would be beneficial to several Rossford locations.

The next meeting will be July 2nd at 5:30pm at the annex.
