Refund/Transfer Request

Refunds: If you request to withdraw from a camp at least 2 weeks or more before the camp starts, a refund will be issued, minus a \$10 refund fee. A refund request less than two weeks before the camp begins will not be approved.

Transfers: If you request to transfer from one camp to another at least two weeks before the camp starts, the transfer will be processed (if space is available). A transfer request less than two weeks before the (registered) camp begins will not be approved.

Payment Plan Option


