



## PRIVACY POLICY

### **Purpose**

This Privacy Policy Statement (the ‘Statement’) is provided by Sevier County (‘County,’ ‘we,’ ‘us,’ or ‘our’) in compliance with Utah State Code Section 63D-2-103.

The County takes data security and the privacy of your personal information very seriously. Sevier County is committed to providing you with websites where you may securely and confidently transact business.

This statement informs users of our websites about the collection and use of personally identifiable information. For the purposes of this statement, ‘Personal Identifiable Information’ means any information relating to an identified or identifiable individual who is the subject of the information. Personally identifiable information is not a classification of records under Utah Code Section 63G, Chapter 2, Government Records Access and Management Act (GRAMA). Access to government records is governed by Utah Code Section 63G, Chapter 2 (GRAMA).

### **No Computer Tracking of Identifiable Information**

Our websites are not set up to track, collect, or distribute personally identifiable information about visitors. Our web server automatically collects limited information about your computer configuration when you visit our websites, including the type of browser you use, the operating system you are running, the website that referred you, and your IP (Internet Protocol) address. The IP numbers of computers (servers) used to visit our websites are noted as part of our statistical analysis on the use of our websites so we may better design services and improve access. However, our websites do not attempt to gain personally identifiable information on individual users and associate them with IP addresses.

In addition, our websites track information about visits to our websites. For example, we compile statistics that show the daily number of visitors to our sites, the daily requests we receive for files on our websites, and what countries those requests come from. These aggregated statistics are used internally to provide better services to the public and may also be provided to others, but the statistics contain no personally identifiable information and cannot be used to gather such information. We can build better websites if we know which pages and features our users are visiting and how often.

### **Basic Confidentiality Policy-Personal Information**

Users do not have to routinely provide personal information to visit Sevier County's websites or to download information. Personal information that you voluntarily supply when you register or initiate transactions, such as your name, address, email, and telephone number, is private and confidential. Accordingly, the personal information you submit through our websites is stored in a secure location, is accessible only by designated staff, and is used only for the purposes for which you provide the information. If you indicate on our sites that you would like to receive information about County programs and services, your personal information will be added to the appropriate subscription lists. You have the right to access and correct personal records, or personal information that relate to you, that you have created through the County, by visiting [www.sevierutah.net](http://www.sevierutah.net), or contacting us at 435-893-0400.

### **Conditional Release of Personal Information to Third Parties**

Personal information will not be released to third parties except to further the purpose for which you provide the information or if the release is required by law or is pertinent to judicial or governmental investigations or proceedings. Any third parties responsible for this information are committed to the same principles and are also required by contract to follow the same policies and guidelines as Sevier County is protecting this information. There are no other circumstances under which we will provide or sell personal information to third parties.
