Rules and Regulations of Cemetery Grounds:

1. Recreational activities are not permitted.
2. Animals are not allowed on Cemetery property.
3. No soliciting, sales or panhandling.
4. No signs or advertisements.
5. Motor vehicles shall travel only on designated roadways without previous consent of the Sexton.
6. Temporary memorials may be removed without notice when they become unsightly or pose a safety hazard or when necessary for regular maintenance.
7. Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by a parent or supervising adult.
8. The grass in the Cemetery may not be disturbed without prior approval of the Sexton.
9. It is unlawful to be present in the Cemetery during night time hours.

Maintenance: Cemetery staff provides regular cleaning, turf care and raising and leveling of monuments and markers.

Clearing of temporary memorials occurs 3 times a year:

1. The week of the 2nd Monday in January.
2. The week of the 2nd Monday in June, *after* Memorial Day.
3. The week of the 1st Monday of October.

Please come to remove memorials that you want to keep on the Friday before the clean-up. You can replace them on the Monday after clean-up week.

Each periodic cleaning will be announced on the City's website, in the City's utility bills, and on-site signage.

Monument/Grave Markers: Monument and grave markers will be installed by private firms. The Sexton's office must receive 24 hours notice before installation. Installers are responsible for the removal of all excess debris and must restore the lot to its original condition. Patrons are responsible for removal and re-installment of any marker or monument deemed oversized by the cemetery staff.

St. George City Cemetery: Upright monuments are allowed only in Plats A & B.

No upright monuments are allowed in a lot within 10 feet of a driveway or tree.

Parking is permitted on the internal roads and curbside on external roads. No vehicles permitted after dark.

Tonaquint Cemetery: Veteran monuments and grave markers must be placed directly east of the single or double monument on the Veteran's lot. Upright monuments are allowed in designated rows. The speed limit in the Cemetery is 15 mph. Parking is restricted to designated spaces along the roads. No vehicles permitted after dark.

Perpetual care fee is NON-refundable



Burial Permits & Payment: No body shall be interred or remains received at any cemetery, unless a burial permit from a licensed mortuary is submitted to the Sexton. Remains from out-of-state shall be accompanied by a Transit Permit. Payment of City burial fees shall be made to the licensed mortuary with required permits, unless burial charges have been paid in advance at the office.

Interment Hours: No interment or graveside service will be held on Sunday or on any holidays officially observed by the City of St. George. Interments and graveside services will be allowed between the hours of 10:00 am - 4:00 pm. All interments & graveside services must be arranged through the Sexton with 48 hours notice.

Perpetual Care: This fee is collected and kept in a special account which may be used for the maintenance and improvement of the cemetery.

Lot Abandonment: A burial lot that has remained empty without burial use for a period of 60 years or more will be presumed abandoned by the lot purchaser. The rights shall be terminated.

Memorial Placement: Temporary memorials must be placed in a raised adjustable receptacle in the monument or concrete border. One shepherd's hook may go adjacent to the concrete border.

Special Events: All special events must be approved and coordinated by the Sexton.
