Special Inspection Agreement

Chapter 17 of the 2021 International Building Code (IBC) has specific requirements for Structural Tests and Special Inspections. These tests and inspections are in addition to the inspections required by IBC 109. These tests and inspections are to be made by an agency approved by the building official.

(Approved Agency)

The Approved Agency must be employed by the owner or the registered design professional in responsible charge acting as the owner's agent.

When special inspection is required by IBC 1704, 1707, or 1708, the registered design professional in responsible charge shall prepare a Statement of Special Inspections, for submittal by the permit applicant. This statement shall include the following:

- 1. The materials, systems, components and work required to have special inspection.
- 2. The type and extent of each inspection.
- 3. The type and extent of each test
- 4. Identification as to whether it will be a continuous or periodic special inspection.

Prior to the issuance of a building permit, a preconstruction meeting shall be held at the Building Officials office. The following are required to attend this meeting:

- 1. The Building Official, Plans Examiner and Building Inspector.
- 2. The Registered Design Professional in Responsible Charge or representative.
- 3. The General Contractor or representative.
- 4. The Approved Agency or representative.

The special inspector shall provide written inspection reports to the building official and the design professional in responsible charge.

A special inspection does not waive the requirement for inspections by the building inspector. The contractor is responsible to schedule all inspections required by IBC 109, with the building department.

A Final Report of Special Inspection shall be provided to the building official. This report shall document the special inspections and corrections of any discrepancies noted in the inspections. The report must be submitted to the building official, for approval, seven days prior to the request for final inspection.

The owner agrees to the following:

- 1. The owner or the design professional in responsible charge is responsible for obtaining tests and/or special inspections, required by IBC Chapter 17, by an agency approved by the building official.
- 2. That all materials, systems and components identified in the Statement of Special Inspection shall be tested and/or inspected in accordance with Chapter 17 of the International Building Code and that written results of those tests and/or inspections are provided to the building official and the design professional in responsible charge.
- 3. The Approved Agency is appointed by the building official to carry out the necessary functions for stop work orders in accordance with the provisions of Section 114 of the International Building Code and the policies and procedures of the City of Saint George Building Inspection Department.
- 4. Testing services will not be performed by the City of St. George.

Ground-fault protection of equipment shall be provided for solidly grounded wye electrical services of more than 150 volts to ground but not exceeding 600 volts phase-to-phase for each service disconnect rated 1000 amperes or more. The ground-fault protection system shall be performance tested when first installed on site. A written record of this test shall be made and shall be available to the authority having jurisdiction. (building official)

Tests of the complete emergency electrical systems, required by NEC 700, shall be witnessed, at the time of installation, by the authority having jurisdiction. (building official)

<u>IBC 107.3.4</u>: The Engineer or Architect in responsible charge is accountable for the review and coordination of all submittal documents designed by others and to ensure they are compatible with the design of the building.

<u>IBC 107.3.4.1</u>: Deferred submittal items are those portions of the design that are not submitted at the time of application and have received prior approval from the building official to be deferred. All deferred submittal items must be listed on the approved plans and be placed in a conspicuous location. The process is as follows:

1. Deferred submittal items must first be reviewed by the design professional in responsible charge.

2. The deferred submittal items are then submitted to the city for review. The Engineer or Architect in responsible charge shall attach a letter to the submittal stating that the deferred item is in conformance with the design of the structure.
