Registration Policies: **Registration:** Registration is accepted on a first come, first served basis until the program is filled, or until the program deadline date, whichever comes first. Online registration is taken at <https://stgeorgerecreation.activityreg.com>

Waitlist: There is no fee to be placed on a camp waitlist. If a spot becomes available in the desired program, the participant's parent/guardian will be notified.

Transfers: A transfer from one activity to another activity is contingent upon availability of spots within the desired program. All registration fee differences must be paid in full prior to the start of the transfer activity. If the new program registration fee is less than the original, a credit will be issued.

Program Cancellation & Refund Policy: The department will issue a full refund if the department cancels a program. Cancellations for a program must be requested a minimum of 2 weeks in advance from the respective activity start date to receive a 100% refund; credits may be issued but subject to Division Program Supervisor. No refunds or credits will be issued once or after the respective activity has begun.

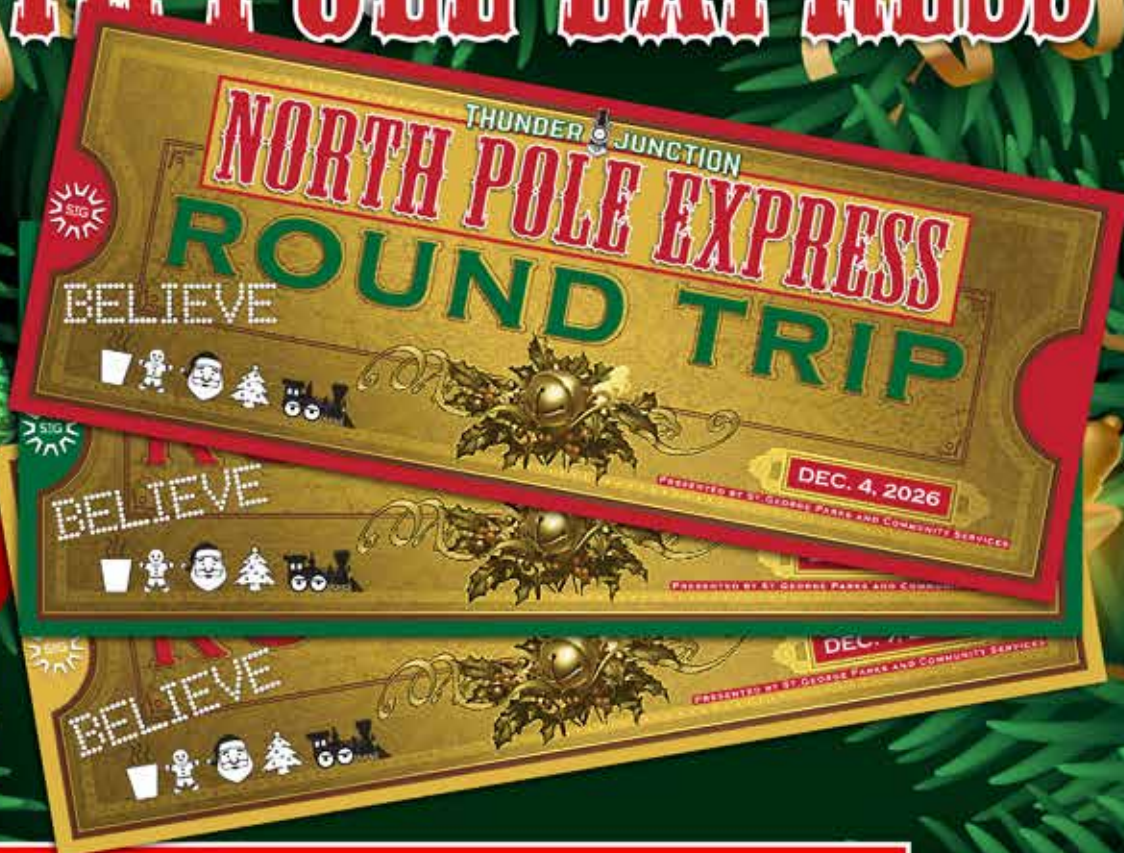

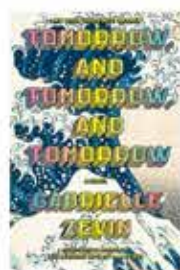

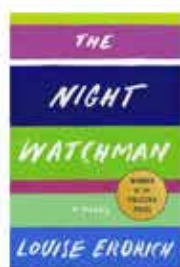
