DOWNTOWN WALKABILITY AND BIKEABILITY COMMUNITY WORKSHOP *Provide Your Input to Improve Walking & Biking Downtown Stockton*

STOCKTON, Calif. – The City of Stockton will host a community workshop to discuss improvements for walking and biking in Downtown Stockton, including adding bike lanes, repairing sidewalks, and upgrading corners at intersections. Community members are encouraged to attend and participate in the meeting on Wednesday, May 22, 2024, 5:30 – 6:30 p.m., at Weber Institute of Applied Sciences & Technology, 302 W. Weber Ave., in the large conference room.

The purpose of the meeting is to share preliminary concepts, gather ideas and community input about common paths of travel and destinations, identify how pedestrians and bicyclists use downtown streets and sidewalks, and determine safety improvements needed for walking and biking in Downtown Stockton.

Community ideas and needs shared at the workshop will assist the City in finalizing the proposed improvement concepts, identifying costs associated with this project, and providing the information needed to apply for funding through the California Transportation Commission Active Transportation Program (ATP). Funding opportunities available through this statewide agency are highly competitive and awarded based on the potential to increase biking and walking to destinations such as shopping, jobs, public transit, and schools.
