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City of Stockton Water Rate Adjustment

The City of Stockton Municipal Utilities Department is committed to providing clean, safe and reliable drinking water at the lowest possible rates to approximately 53,000 residential and commercial connections in north and south Stockton. After a series of public notices and meetings in accordance with Proposition 218, a new five-year rate plan was adopted by Resolution 2021-05-25-1602, at a Public Hearing on May 25, 2021.

Per Government Code 53756, the City of Stockton Municipal Utilities Department is notifying customers that an adjustment to water rates as shown in the table below will take place effective July 1, 2025. Simple Steps to Save Water

Around the Yard



Water plants before 8 am or after 6 pm and set lawn mower blades to 3".

Invest in water-wise and drought-resistant plants, install drip irrigation and add mulch to gardens.



Use a pool cover to reduce evaporation. Approval is required to drain or refill swimming pools between June 1 and October 1. Call the Water Field Office at (209) 937-7031 and press 5.

Use alternative pest control measures. If a pesticide is necessary, choose the least-toxic or plant-based product. Read the label carefully before applying to prevent the pollution of our local waterways.



Around the House

Set a timer & shower for 5 minutes or less.



Wash only full loads of dishes and clothes.

Turn off water when brushing teeth and shaving.



Test toilet tanks for leaks and fix leaks inside the home.

Fill bathtub halfway or less; install faucet aerators.
