

**Amendment No. 4 - 2023 Operating Budget - April 2023**

<b>a.</b>	<b>122 - ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT FUND</b>	<b>FUNDING SOURCE: STATE HOTEL/MOTEL TAX APPROPRIATION</b>
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To amend the budget for the transfer of funds for the Fishing Pier-Hurricane Ida Capital Project to assess the fishing pier, office, bathroom building, parking lot, road, and any other Parish-owned buildings or equipment associated with the St. Tammany Parish Fishing Pier for repairs due to Hurricane Ida, and develop construction documents for the repair and mitigation of the pier and associated structures.

The damage assessment as prepared by Meyer Engineers was submitted to FEMA in order to request public assistance under Disaster 4611 (Hurricane Ida) for the repairs and mitigation of the St. Tammany Parish Fishing Pier and related facilities. FEMA is currently reviewing the assessment and will prepare a project based on the authorized repairs and mitigation measures, including design costs. The Economic Development funding is being used to prepare the design, so the project is moving concurrently with the FEMA obligation process to avoid delays.

The intent is to reimburse the economic development fund for design work once the project is obligated by FEMA. The local cost share of 10% and any ineligible FEMA expenditures for the pier repair will be funded from the ED fund after utilizing available grant funds from the BP Tourism Grant of \$338,330.03. Based on the estimated \$2,500,000 project costs, a \$250,000 local cost share is anticipated.
