**ADOPTING AUTHORIZATION REGULATIONS FOR THE OPERATION OF  
EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE FOR THE COUNTY OF SUMMIT, STATE OF  
COLORADO AND REPEALING THE EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES RULES AND  
REGULATIONS FOR THE COUNTY OF SUMMIT, STATE OF COLORADO**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the authority granted in the Colorado Emergency Medical Services Act, C.R.S. § 25-3.5-101, et seq., (the “Act”), and the State Board of Health Rules Pertaining to Emergency Medical Services 6 CCR 1015-3 (the “Rules”), the Board of County Commissioners of Summit County, Colorado (“BOCC”) are authorized to adopt and enact requirements regarding the authorization to operate ambulance services within the County and

**WHEREAS**, the State of Colorado through the Department of Public Health and Environment has consolidated ambulance services licensing at the state level; and

**WHEREAS**, the BOCC desires to continue to be the authorizing entity for all ambulance services provide within Summit County; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ambulance Authorization Regulations are intended to prescribe the requirements for the delivery of high quality, coordinated Emergency Medical Services to all visitors and residents in Summit County in accordance with the Act; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF SUMMIT, STATE OF COLORADO, THAT:**

1. The Emergency Medical Service Rules and Regulations for Summit County, Colorado, as provided in Resolution No. 2023-27, are hereby repealed.
2. The Emergency Medical Service Rules and Regulations for Summit County, Colorado, attached as Attachment “A,” are hereby adopted.
