



## Solid Waste Hauler License Self -Certification

Applicant must initial the items below, complete , sign for self-certification and submit with the annual application for a Solid Waste Hauler License .

\_\_\_\_\_ Each vehicle operated in the performance of waste hauling services, as licensed under the Summit County Trash Hauler Licensing Ordinance 2017-2(A), is insured through a policy issued by an insurance carrier or insurer, authorized to do business in the State of Colorado:

\_\_\_\_\_ in the sum of not less than \$150,000.00 for damages for or on account of any bodily injury to or the death of each person as the result of any one accident;

\_\_\_\_\_ in the sum of not less than \$150,000.00 for damages to the property of others as the result of any one accident, and;

\_\_\_\_\_ in the total sum of not less than \$400,000.00 for or on account of any bodily injury to or the death of all persons and for the damages to the property of others.

\_\_\_\_\_ Each person under my employment has the legal right to work in the United States

\_\_\_\_\_ Each person under my employment is covered as required by Workman's Compensation Insurance as provided by State law in accordance with the Workers' Compensation Act of Colorado.

\_\_\_\_\_ Each vehicle operated in the performance of waste hauling services, as licensed under the Summit County Commercial Waste Hauler Licensing Ordinance 2017-2(A), is maintained in road-worthy and good condition and statements below, where applicable, are correct and true.

\_\_\_\_\_ All compaction and roll-off vehicles designed and used for hauling putrescible (liquid containing) wastes are leak proof at all times during operation.

\_\_\_\_\_ All compaction vehicles are maintained to ensure that compaction blades move freely, hopper plugs and seals are in place, in good condition (not cracked), and are leak proof.

\_\_\_\_\_ Only vehicles designed to haul putrescible (liquid containing) wastes are used for this purpose. Regular pickups and flat bed vehicles are only used to haul dry wastes.

\_\_\_\_\_ All open-bed or open-top vehicles are provided with a tarpaulin of sufficient size to cover all loads entirely, and to be used whenever waste is being transported to avoid littering or loss of load onto the highway.

\_\_\_\_\_ If vehicles have sideboards or a tailgate, these components are constructed of permanent materials.

I have completed the information being submitted above for compliance with the Summit County Solid Waste Hauler Licensing Ordinance No. 2017-2(A) and, based on information and belief formed after reasonable inquiry, I certify that I have the legal authority to sign for the Solid Waste Hauler and that the statements and information contained in this submittal are true, accurate and complete. I also certify that I have all necessary business licenses to operate the services I am providing.

I am aware that failure to provide true and accurate and complete information on this self-certification form constitutes a violation of requirements in the Trash Hauler Licensing Ordinance No. 2017-2(A) and is a Class 2 petty offense as provided for in Section 30-15-402(1) C.R.S., and is punishable by a fine of not more than one thousand dollars (\$1000.00) for each separate violation and may also result

in the suspension or revocation of my license.
