SCALE PROCEDURE:

All vehicles must check-in at the scale house. Proceed slowly onto and off the scales. Wait until you get the green light or vehicles to clear scale before driving on. Scale needs to zero between vehicles to get accurate weight. Do not shift gears or come to an abrupt halt, this can damage the scales.

Shut down engine while speaking with the gatehouse technician.

ALL LOADS MUST BE COVERED ON HIGHWAYS PRIOR TO COMING TO SCRAP

Accepted payment: cash, check, and card

ID and phone number required for checks and \$0.25+2% convenience fee on all cards

One-way traffic and a **14.5 mph** speed limit throughout landfill. Landfill equipment has right of way.

NO cell phone use, scavenging, children or pets out of vehicle, or smoking.

NO paints, tires, batteries, liquids, fuels, oils, propane tanks, or electronic waste in your trash load; specific requirements apply to these items.
