

MINUTES OF THE TOWN OF SMYRNA BEER BOARD

January 6, 2020

The January meeting of the Town of Smyrna Beer Board was held on Monday, January 6, 2020. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Matthew Fry at 5:00 p.m. at Town Hall, Smyrna, Tennessee.

The pledge of allegiance was led by Chairman Matthew Fry.

Matthew Fry, Molly Jennings, Scott Matuk, Amanda Newbern, and Miranda Swift were present. Town Attorney Jeff Peach and Town Clerk Dianne Waldron were also in attendance.

There were no citizen comments to consider.

The Board first considered a motion by Scott Matuk to approve the minutes of the December 2, 2019 regular meeting of the Beer Board. The motion was duly seconded by Amanda Newbern. Following discussion, the motion was approved unanimously.

The Board next considered an application for an on-premises permit to sell beer from Zen, Inc. dba Yummy Poki, 901 Rock Springs Road, Suite 110. Chairman Matthew Fry called the public hearing to order. You Hong Liu spoke, with the aid of an interpreter, concerning the application. Following discussion, Scott Matuk made a motion to deny the application based on the distance to two churches and a daycare. The motion was duly seconded by Molly Jennings. Following further discussion, the motion was approved unanimously. A copy of said application, as denied, is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit "1".

There was no further old business to consider.

There were no applications for the Beer Board to consider under new business.

Town Attorney Jeff Peach announced that Staff Attorney Nathan Nichols has taken a new job with the District Attorney's office.
