There was no old business to consider.



Following discussion, Vice-Chairwoman Miranda Swift made a motion to defer the application to the March meeting to allow staff to obtain a second measurement to the Smyrna Assembly of God. 
The next meeting of the Beer Board will be March 2, 2020.
