

MINUTES OF THE TOWN OF SMYRNA BEER BOARD

March 2, 2020

The March meeting of the Town of Smyrna Beer Board was held on Monday, March 2, 2020. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Matthew Fry at 5:00 p.m. at Town Hall, Smyrna, Tennessee.

The pledge of allegiance was led by Scott Matuk.

Matthew Fry, Molly Jennings, Scott Matuk, and Miranda Swift were present. Amanda Newbern was not in attendance. Town Attorney Jeff Peach and Town Clerk Dianne Waldron were also in attendance.

There were no citizen comments to consider.

The Board first considered a motion by Scott Matuk to approve the minutes of the February 3, 2020 regular meeting of the Beer Board. The motion was duly seconded by Vice-Chairwoman Miranda Swift. Following discussion, the motion was approved unanimously.

The Board next considered an application for an on-premises permit to sell beer from J-Lou Tacos, 1017 Rock Springs Road. Chairman Matthew Fry called the public hearing to order. Lourdes Maria Bello spoke concerning the application. Town Attorney Jeff Peach stated the laser measurement was 488 feet which was too close to Smyrna Assembly of God. Following discussion, Vice-Chairwoman Miranda Swift made a motion to defer the application to the April meeting to allow owners to address the distance. The motion was duly seconded by Molly Jennings. Following further discussion, the motion was approved 3-1 with Scott Matuk voting "no".

There was no further old business to consider.

The Board next considered an application for an off-premises permit to sell beer from Nimri Market, 228 North Lowry Street. Chairman Matthew Fry called the public hearing to order. Nabeel Sami Alnimri spoke concerning the application. Following discussion, Scott Matuk made a motion to approve the application. The motion was duly seconded by Vice-Chairwoman Miranda Swift. Following further discussion, the motion was approved unanimously. A copy of said application, as approved, is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit "1".

Chairman Matthew Fry thanked Molly Jennings for her eight years of service on the Beer Board.

The next meeting of the Beer Board will be April 6, 2020.


There being no further business to come before the Board, Scott Matuk made a motion to adjourn the meeting. The motion was duly seconded by Vice-Chairwoman Miranda Swift. Following discussion, the motion was approved unanimously. The meeting was adjourned at 5:16 p.m.
