

MINUTES OF THE TOWN OF SMYRNA BEER BOARD

June 1, 2020

The June meeting of the Town of Smyrna Beer Board was held on Monday, June 1, 2020. The meeting was called to order by Vice-Chairman Matthew Fry at 5:00 p.m. at Town Hall, Smyrna, Tennessee.

The Board next considered an application for an off-premises permit to sell beer from Gil's Food Mart, 100 Gil's Street. Vice-Chairman Matthew Fry called the public hearing to order. Eva Abdelnor spoke concerning the application. Following discussion, Scott Matuk made a motion to approve the application. The motion was duly seconded by Amanda Newbern. The Board next considered an application for an off-premises permit to sell beer from RaceTrac Petroleum, Inc. dba RaceTrac #2568, 1770 Lee Victory Parkway. Vice-Chairman Matthew Fry called the public hearing to order. A representative of the business was not present at the meeting. Following discussion, Scott Matuk made a motion to move the item to the heel of the agenda. The motion was duly seconded by Amanda Newbern. Following further discussion, the motion was approved unanimously.

The Board next considered an application for an on-premises permit to sell beer from Cracker Barrel Old Country Store, Inc. dba Cracker Barrel Old Country Store #429, 2697 Highwood Boulevard. Vice-Chairman Matthew Fry called the public hearing to order. Attorney Tayo Atanda of Waller Lansden Dortch & Davis, LLP spoke concerning the application. Following discussion, Amanda Newbern made a motion to approve the application. The motion was duly seconded by Scott Matuk. Following further discussion, the motion was approved unanimously.
