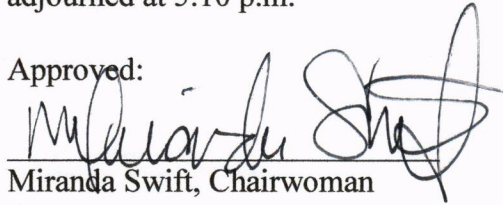

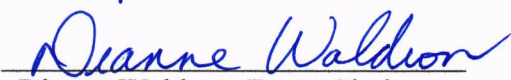
Chairwoman Miranda Swift stated the next meeting will be August 2, 2021.
