

MINUTES OF THE TOWN OF SMYRNA BEER BOARD

July 11, 2022

The July meeting of the Town of Smyrna Beer Board was held on Monday, July 11, 2022. The meeting was called to order by Chairwoman Miranda Swift, at 5:05 p.m. at Town Hall, Smyrna, Tennessee.

The pledge of allegiance was led by Chairwoman Miranda Swift.

Chairwoman Miranda Swift, Vice-Chairwoman Amanda Newbern, and board members Crystal Stone and Michael Forrest were present. Matthew Fry was absent. Attorney Eric Hennessee and Town Clerk Amber Hobbs were also in attendance.

There were no citizen comments to consider.

The Board first considered under old business an application for an off premise permit to sell beer from Six Stars, Inc. (10412 Old Nashville Highway). Said application was laid on the table at the previous meeting. Board member Michael Forrest made a motion to take the application from the table. The motion was seconded by Chairwoman Miranda Swift and approved unanimously.


