

MINUTES OF THE TOWN OF SMYRNA BEER BOARD

October 10, 2022

The September meeting of the Town of Smyrna Beer Board was held on Monday, October 10, 2022. The meeting was called to order by Chairwoman Miranda Swift, at 5:00 p.m. at Town Hall, Smyrna, Tennessee.

Chairwoman Miranda Swift called the public hearing to order. Owner, Lattana Bridges, spoke concerning the application. Following discussion, Crystal Stone mad a motion to approve the off premise permit application. The motion was duly seconded by Michael Forrest. 

Following discussion, Crystal Stone mad a motion to approve the off premise permit application. The motion was duly seconded by Michael Forrest.
