

MINUTES OF THE TOWN OF SMYRNA BEER BOARD

November 7, 2022

The November meeting of the Town of Smyrna Beer Board was held on Monday, November 7, 2022. The meeting was called to order by Board Member Matthew Fry, at 5:00 p.m. at Town Hall, Smyrna, Tennessee.

The pledge of allegiance was led by Board Member Matthew Fry.

Board members Matthew Fry, Crystal Stone and Michael Forrest were present. Chairwoman Miranda Swift and Vice-Chairwoman Amanda Newbern were absent. Town Attorney Jeff Peach and Town Clerk Amber Hobbs were also in attendance.

There were no citizen comments to consider.

The Board first considered a motion by board member Crystal Stone to approve the minutes of the October 10, 2022 regular meeting of the Beer Board. The motion was duly seconded by board member Michael Forrest. Following discussion, the motion was approved unanimously.

There were no old business items for the Board to consider.

The Board next considered under new business an application for an on premise permit to sell beer from RNR Smyrna, LLC dba Rock N' Roll Sushi, (582 Sam Ridley Pkwy, Smyrna). Board Member Matthew Fry called the public hearing to order. Owner, Phillip McClellan, and Ryan spoke concerning the application. Following discussion, Michael Forrest mad a motion to approve the on premise permit application. The motion was duly seconded by Crystal Stone. Following further discussion, Board Member Matthew Fry reiterated a contingency that owner, Chase McCleskey, provide a valid, unexpired copy of his driver's license prior to issuance of the permit. With this contingency, the motion was approved unanimously. A copy of said document is attached and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit "1".

The Board next considered under new business an application for an on premise permit to sell beer from Brittany L. Slate d/b/a Pop's Bar and Grill (117 Front Street, Smyrna). Board Member Matthew Fry called the public hearing to order. Owner, Brittany L. Slate, spoke concerning the application. Following discussion, Michael Forrest made a motion to approve the on premise permit application. The motion was duly seconded by Crystal Stone. Following further discussion, the motion was approved unanimously. A copy of said document is attached and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit "2".

There were no further new business items for the Board to consider.

Board Member Matthew Fry stated that the next meeting will be December 5, 2022.

There being no further business to come before the Board, Michael Forrest made a motion to adjourn the meeting. The motion was duly seconded by Crystal Stone. Following discussion, the motion was approved unanimously. The meeting was adjourned at 5:10 p.m.
