

MINUTES OF THE TOWN OF SMYRNA BEER BOARD

January 9, 2023

The January meeting of the Town of Smyrna Beer Board was held on Monday, January 9, 2023. The meeting was called to order by Chairwoman, Miranda Swift, at 5:01 p.m. at Town Hall, Smyrna, Tennessee.

The pledge of allegiance was led by Chairwoman Miranda Swift.

Chairwoman Miranda Swift, along with board members Crystal Stone and Michael Forrest were present. Board Members Matthew Fry and Vice-Chairwoman Amanda Newbern were absent. Attorney Jason King and Town Clerk Amber Hobbs were also in attendance.

There were no citizen comments to consider.

The Board first considered a motion by Crystal Stone to approve the minutes of the December 5, 2022 regular meeting of the Beer Board. The motion was duly seconded by board member Michael Forrest. Following discussion, the motion was approved unanimously.

There were no old business items for the Board to consider.

The Board next considered under new business an application for on premise permit to sell beer from Print Shop Smyrna, LLC dba Print Shop Smyrna, (1 N Lowry Street, Smyrna). Chairwoman Miranda Swift called the public hearing to order. Owner, Caleb Spearing, and manager, Alberto Villalobos, spoke concerning the application. Following discussion, board member Michael Forrest made a motion to approve the on premise permit application. The motion was duly seconded by board member Crystal Stone. Following further discussion, the motion was approved unanimously. A copy of said document is attached and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit "1".

At this time, Town Clerk, Amber Hobbs, communicated to applicant, Caleb Spearing, that it was brought to the board's attention through the Town's treasury department that Print Shop Smyrna, LLC had not yet registered for a local business tax license and would need to do so prior to picking up their approved beer permit. Amber further communicated that she would follow up with applicant after the meeting to provide instruction and contact for completing this process.

The Board next considered under new business an application for on premise permit to sell beer from LG Food Incorporated (Bonchon Korean Fried Chicken, 578 Sam Ridley Pkwy W, Smyrna). Chairwoman Miranda Swift called the public hearing to order. Manager, Neng Guo Lan, spoke concerning the application. Following discussion, board member Michael Forrest made a motion to approve the on premise permit application. The motion was duly seconded by board member, Crystal Stone. Following further discussion, the motion was approved unanimously. A copy of said document is attached and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit "2".

There were no further new business items for the Board to consider.

Chairwoman Miranda Swift stated that the next meeting will be February 6, 2023.


There being no further business to come before the Board, Crystal Stone made a motion to adjourn the meeting. The motion was duly seconded by Michael Forrest. Following discussion, the motion was approved unanimously. The meeting was adjourned at 5:07 p.m.
