

MINUTES OF THE TOWN OF SMYRNA BEER BOARD

June 5, 2023

The June meeting of the Town of Smyrna Beer Board was held on Monday, June 5, 2023. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson, Ben Franklin, at 5:01 p.m. at Town Hall, Smyrna, Tennessee. The pledge of allegiance was led by Chairperson, Ben Franklin.

Chairperson Ben Franklin, Vice-Chairperson Crystal Stone, and Board Members Amy Harrison and Stephen Cramer were present. Board Member Michael Forrest was not present for the meeting. Attorney Jason King and Town Clerk Amber Hobbs were also in attendance.

There were no citizen comments to consider.

The Board first considered a motion by Board Member Stephen Cramer to approve the minutes of the May 1, 2023 regular meeting of the Beer Board. The motion was duly seconded by Vice-Chairperson Crystal Stone. Following discussion, the motion was approved unanimously.

The Board next welcomed newly appointed member, Amy Harrison, to her term on the Beer Board.

There was one old business item for the Board to consider; an application for on premise permit at 2 Brothers Pizzeria and Restaurant. Owner, Anthony Garcia, spoke concerning the application. Following discussion, Chairperson Ben Franklin made a motion to defer the on premise permit application to the July 2023 meeting and requested that applicant provide the board with an updated General Partnership Agreement showing current ownership percentages for owners Anthony Garcia and Jose Oscar Garcia. The motion to defer was duly seconded by Board Member Amy Harrison, and following further discussion, approved unanimously. The Board next considered under new business an application for on premise permit for Karen Thai and Sushi, LLC dba Karen Thai and Sushi. Owner, Lamthoun Pathana, spoke concerning the application. Following discussion, Board Member Stephen Cramer made a motion to approve the on premise permit. The motion was duly seconded by Vice-Chairperson Crystal Stone. Following further discussion, the motion was approved unanimously. A copy of said document is attached and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit "2".

There were no further new business items for the Board to consider.

Chair Person Ben Franklin stated that, due to the Independence Day holiday, the next meeting will be held July 10, 2023.
