

# **MINUTES OF THE TOWN OF SMYRNA BEER BOARD**

July 10, 2023

The July meeting of the Town of Smyrna Beer Board was held on Monday, July 10, 2023. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson, Ben Franklin, at 5:01 p.m. at Town Hall, Smyrna, Tennessee. The pledge of allegiance was led by Chairperson, Ben Franklin.

Chairperson Ben Franklin, Vice-Chairperson Crystal Stone, and Board Members Amy Harrison, Stephen Cramer and Michael Forrest were present for the meeting. Attorney Jason King and Town Clerk Amber Hobbs were also in attendance.

There were no citizen comments to consider.

The Board first considered a motion by Crystal Stone to approve the minutes of the June 5, 2023 regular meeting of the Beer Board. The motion was duly seconded by Michael Forrest. Following discussion, the motion was approved unanimously.

There was one old business item for the Board to consider, an application for on premise permit at 2 Brothers Pizzeria and Restaurant. Owner, Anthony Garcia, spoke concerning the application. Following discussion, Board Member Stephen Cramer made a motion to approve the on premise permit application. The motion was duly seconded by Vice-Chairperson Crystal Stone, and following further discussion, approved unanimously. The Board next considered under new business an application for off premise permit for Brian Tobacco and Beer. Owner, Nabeel Sami Al Nimri, spoke concerning the application. Following discussion, Board Member Amy Harrison made a motion to approve the off premise permit. The motion was duly seconded by Board Member Michael Forrest. 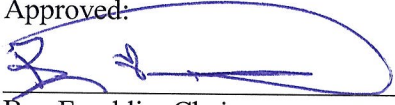
