

## MINUTES OF THE TOWN OF SMYRNA BEER BOARD

May 6, 2024

The May meeting of the Town of Smyrna Beer Board was held on Monday, May 6, 2024. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Amy Harrison, at 5:01 p.m. at Town Hall, Smyrna, Tennessee. The pledge of allegiance was led by Chairperson Amy Harrison.

Chairperson Amy Harrison, Vice-Chairperson Jason Surratt and Board Members Benjamin Franklin, Michael Forrest and Jennifer Brittain were present for the meeting. Staff Attorney Benjamin Groce and Town Clerk Amber Hobbs were also in attendance.

There were no citizen comments to consider.

The Board first considered a motion by Board Member Ben Franklin to approve the minutes of the April 1, 2024 regular meeting of the Beer Board. The motion was duly seconded by Vice-Chairperson Jason Surratt and subsequently approved 5-0.

There were no old business items for the Board to consider.

The Board next considered under new business an application for an off-premise permit for Puff N Stuff Inc. dba Puff N Stuff Vape Tobacco & Beer, 289 Enon Springs Rd E, Smyrna. Owner, Amir Samuel, spoke concerning the application. Following discussion, Board Member, Michael Forrest, made a motion to approve the off-premise permit for this location. The motion was duly seconded by Board Member Ben Franklin. Following further discussion, the motion was approved unanimously. The Board next considered under new business an application for an on-premise permit for Napoleon III, Inc. dba Cinco De Mayo, Inc., 820 Expo Drive, Smyrna. No representative was present at the meeting to speak concerning the application. Following discussion, Board Member, Ben Franklin made a motion to defer consideration of this application to the June meeting to allow opportunity for a representative to be present and answer questions related to the application. The motion was duly seconded by Vice-Chairperson Jason Surratt. Following further discussion, the motion to defer was approved unanimously.

The Board next considered under new business an application for an off-premise permit for Sam Ridley Shell, Inc. 500 Sam Ridley Pkwy E, Smyrna. Owner, Manish Patel, spoke concerning the application. Following discussion, Vice-Chairperson Jason Surratte made a motion to approve the off-premise permit for this location. The motion was duly seconded by Board Member Michael Forrest. Following further discussion, the motion was approved unanimously. A copy of said document is attached and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit "2".

There were no further new business items for the Board to consider.
