

**MINUTES OF MEETING OF THE REGULAR SESSION OF THE
TOWN COUNCIL
OF THE TOWN OF SMYRNA
ON DECEMBER 14, 2017**

The Town Council of the Town of Smyrna, Rutherford County, Tennessee, met in regular session at 5:00 p.m. on December 14, 2017 at Town Hall with the Honorable Marc Adkins, Vice-Mayor, presiding.

Vice-Mayor Adkins called the meeting to order. The invocation was offered by Council Member Steve Sullivan. The pledge of allegiance was led by Mike Moss, Director of Parks and Recreation.

1. Approval or Correction of Minutes of the November 14 and November 30, 2017 meetings.

The Town Council first considered a motion by Council Member Tim Morrell to approve the minutes of the November 14, 2017 regular session of the Town Council and the November 30, 2017 work session of the Town Council. The motion was duly seconded by Council Member Steve Sullivan. Following discussion, the motion was approved unanimously.

LaDawna Parham, Director of Nourish Food Bank, addressed the Town Council thanking them for the recent food drive.

3. Awards and Recognitions.

8. Announcements.

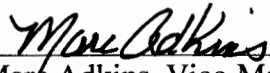
Vice-Mayor Marc Adkins and the Council Members wished everyone a “Merry Christmas”.

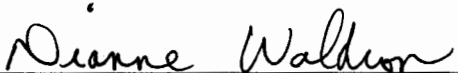
