NEW BUSINESS

1. **Consideration of amendment to Ordinance #22-18 adopting the certified property tax rate for fiscal year 2022-2023.**


The Town Council first considered amendment of Ordinance #22-18 adopting the certified property tax rate for fiscal year 2022-2023, as the rate was not yet certified by the Assessor at the time of second reading and public hearing on June 7, 2022. After discussion, a motion was made by Council Member Tim Morrell to adopt the certified tax rate for fiscal year 2022-2023 at .5257, and amend Ordinance #22-18 to reflect said adjustment in property tax rate from that passed on second reading at .5323. The motion was duly seconded by Council Member Racquel Peebles. Following discussion, the motion was approved 6-0.

2. Approval of the license agreement for the installation of network facilities within the right of way.

The Town Council next considered approval of the terms of, and authorization for Mayor to execute, a license agreement with Google Fiber for the installation of network facilities within the Town's right of way. After discussion, a motion was made by Council Member Gerry Short to approve said terms and grant Mayor authorization to enter said agreement with Google Fiber. The motion was duly seconded by Vice-Mayor Marc Adkins. Following discussion, the motion was approved 6-0.

There being no further business to come before the Town Council, the meeting was adjourned at 5:03 p.m.
