

TOWNSEND WATER DEPARTMENT

How is my bill calculated?

All customers are billed quarterly and are charged a Unit charge per quarter of \$50.00.

TIMBERLEE PARK CUSTOMERS

Meters in Timberlee Park register water usage in gallons. For billing purposes usage is then measured and calculated by a predetermined amount per 1000 gallons. In this case \$7.71/1000 gallons of water used. For example:

Current Meter Reading	1254500
Previous Meter Reading	1240500
Usage	14,000

Your bill is calculated as follows: $\$50.00 + \$7.71 \times 14 = \$157.94$
 or
 $\$50.00 + \$107.94 = \$157.94$

Residential 1000 gallon meters

Tier 1	0-15 Units	\$7.71
Tier 2	15-30 units	\$11.57
Tier 3	30-45 Units	\$15.43
Tier 4	45 and over	\$19.28

ALL OTHER CUSTOMERS

Meters register water in cubic feet. For billing purposes usage is then measured and calculated by a predetermined amount per 100 cubic feet. In this case \$5.77/100 cubic feet of water used.

For example:

Current Meter Reading	25800
Previous Meter Reading	25100
Usage	700

Your bill is calculated as follows: $\$50.00 + \$5.77 \times 7 = \$90.39$
 or
 $\$50.00 + \$40.39 = \$90.39$

Residential 100 cubic ft (748 gallons) meters

Tier 1	0-15 Units	\$5.77
Tier 2	15-30 units	\$8.66
Tier 3	30-45 Units	\$11.54
Tier 4	45 and over	\$14.43
