The opening of the quiet study space was complete with a ribbon cutting with Troy Mayor, Ethan Baker and City Manager, Mark Miller joined by members of the public on December 7, 2023.



For years, one of the most frequent requests received by Library staff was for improved study spaces in the building to accommodate today's users and their technology.

Library Director Emily Dumas says, "We recently passed a Library millage and Troy voters have been eager for building improvements. I am proud to offer this new study space to our patrons. I am glad we could finally fulfill this need for our community."



The area includes modern, flexible furniture with USB-friendly outlets in all of the stations. There are different seating options for group and individual studying which offer varying levels of privacy.

"Library staff worked with OHM Advisors to plan and design the area," Library Assistant Director Phillip Kwik says, "We wanted to create an experience for today's library user that is both comfortable and functional."
