Proposed Amendment #7 To The Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery Program Action Plan For Disaster Recovery

The Town of Union is proposing an amendment to the Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) Action Plan for Disaster Recovery. The amendment will authorize and create a new project for channel/stream erosion repairs and stabilization measures in the vicinity of Frost Rd. and Ivon Avenue as recommended by the Broome County Soil and Water Conservation District. The amendment further authorizes a transfer of CDBG-DR funds up to an amount currently estimated to be \$15,000 from the Town's CDBG-DR unprogrammed funds budget line.
