## VAN BUREN TOWNSHIP DDA EXTENDS PARTNERSHIP WITH DETROIT REGION AEROTROPOLIS

Van Buren Township (July 2017) - The Van Buren Township Downtown Development Authority voted to extend its collaboration with the **Detroit Region Aerotropolis** for another year, with several conditions. The DDA wants quarterly updates during the next year as well as assurance of a seat on the executive board under the proposed changes to the Inter-Local Agreement.

Business attraction and development is a common goal shared by the Detroit Region Aerotropolis and the Van Buren Township Downtown Development Authority, creating a significant window of opportunity. The new **Executive Director of the Detroit Region** Aerotropolis, Robert Luce, requested the opportunity to present a 3-year plan to the


